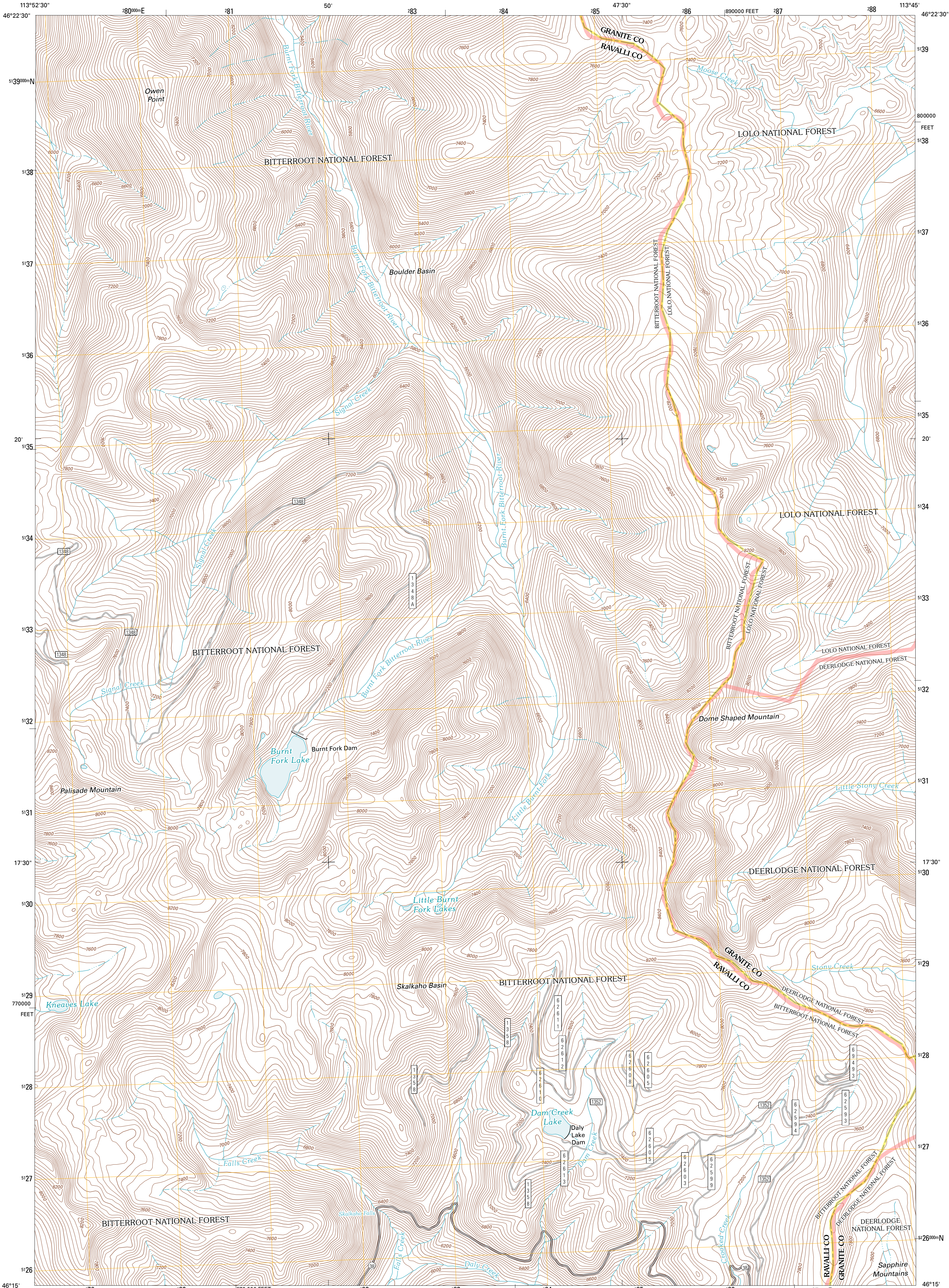

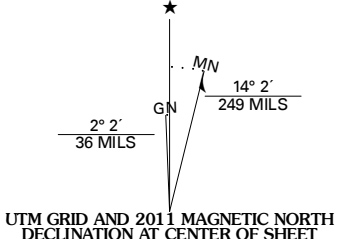


BURNT FORK LAKE QUADRANGLE

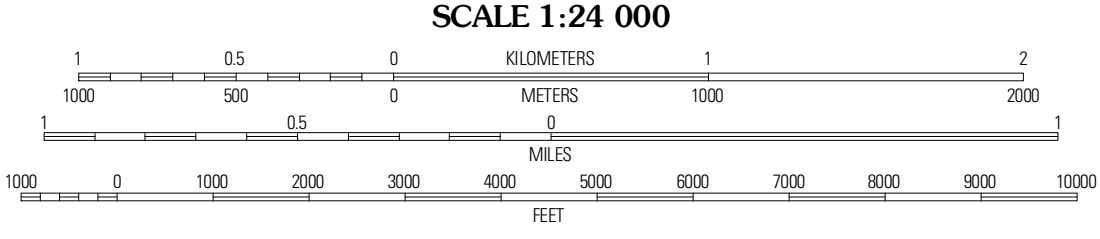
