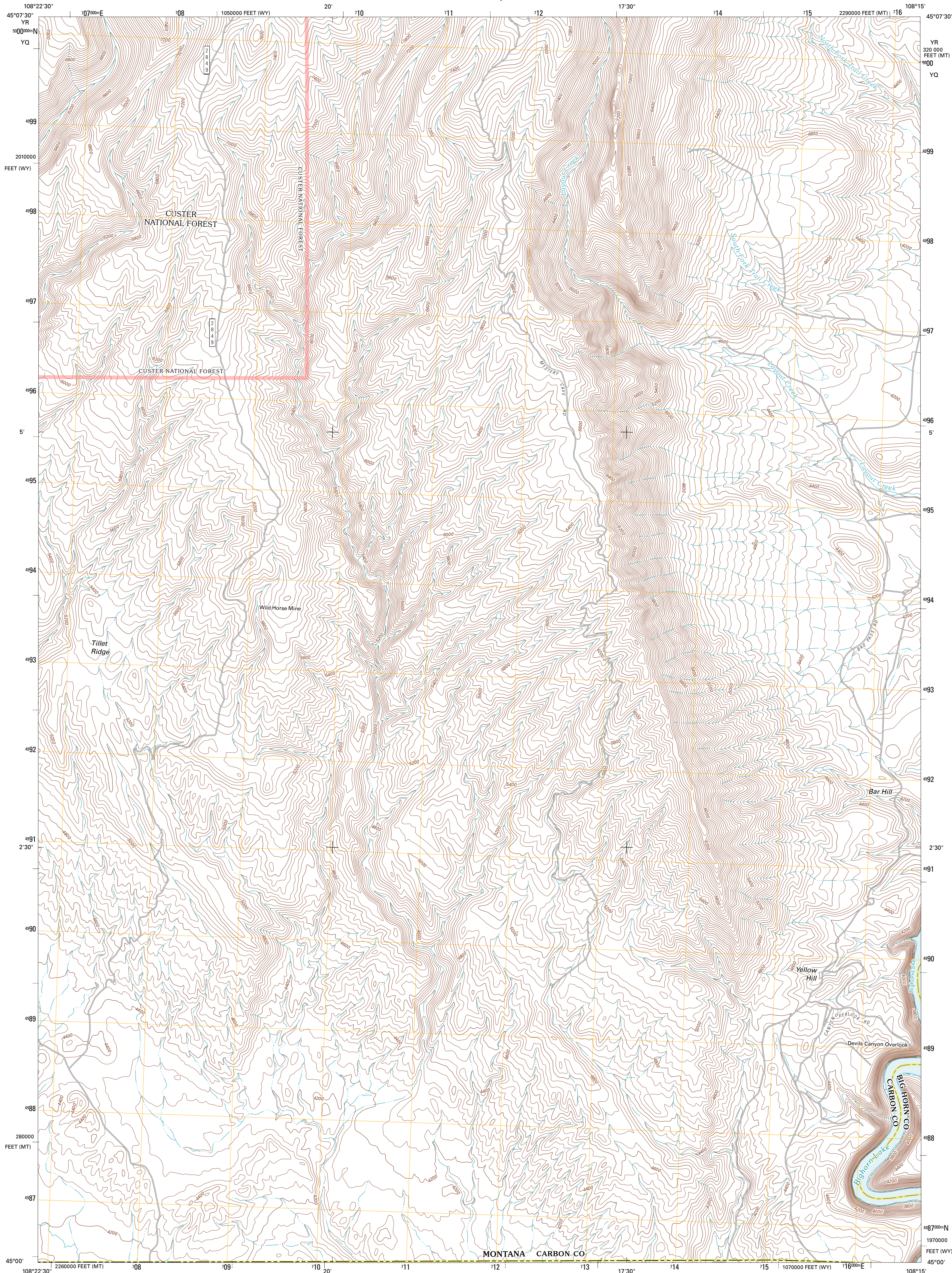

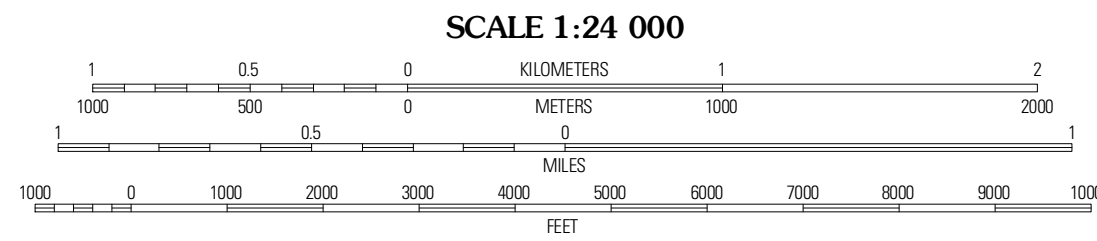
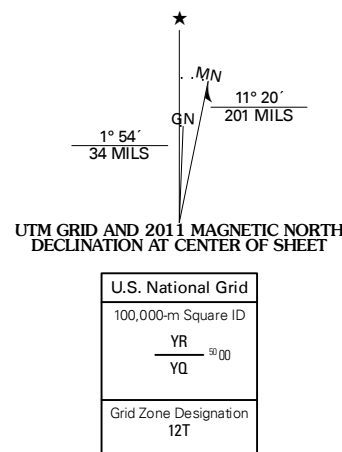


MYSTERY CAVE QUADRANGLE
