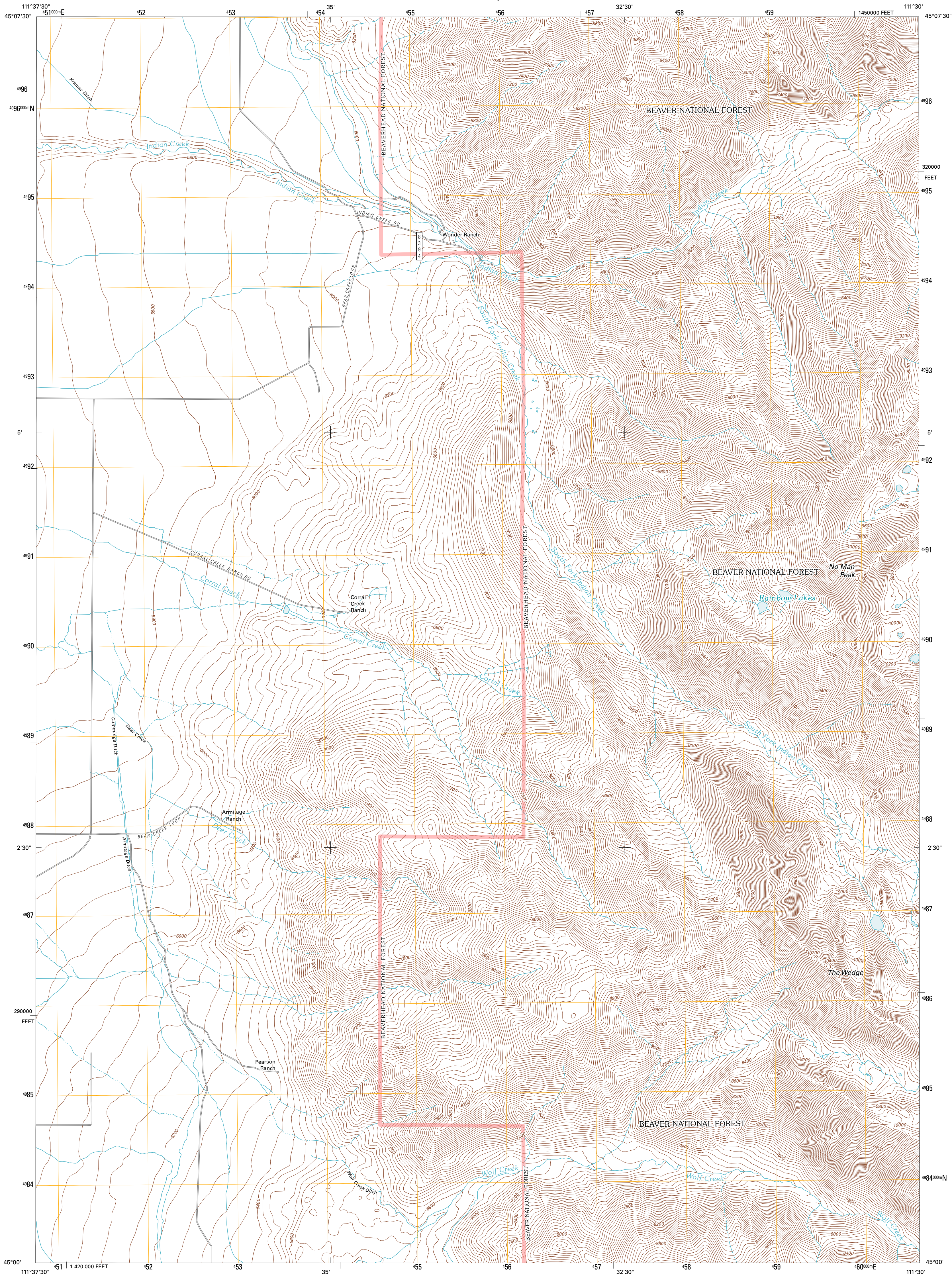

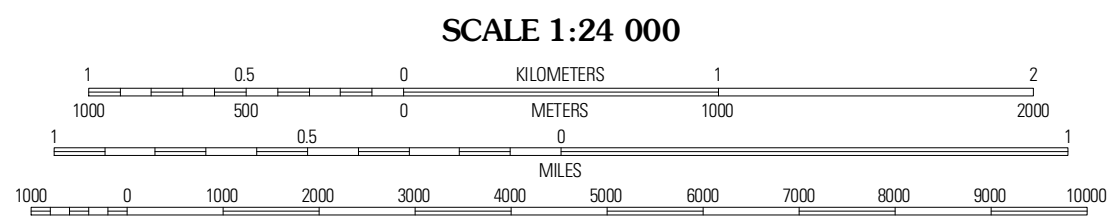
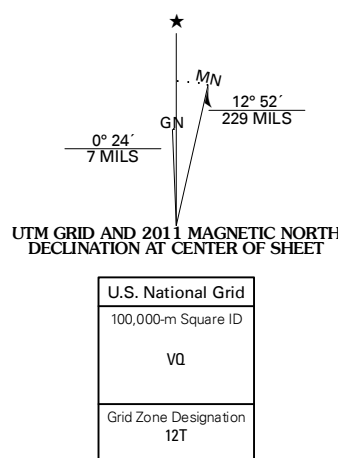


NO MAN PEAK QUADRANGLE

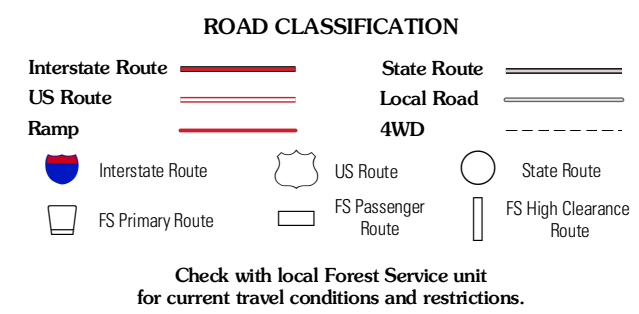
