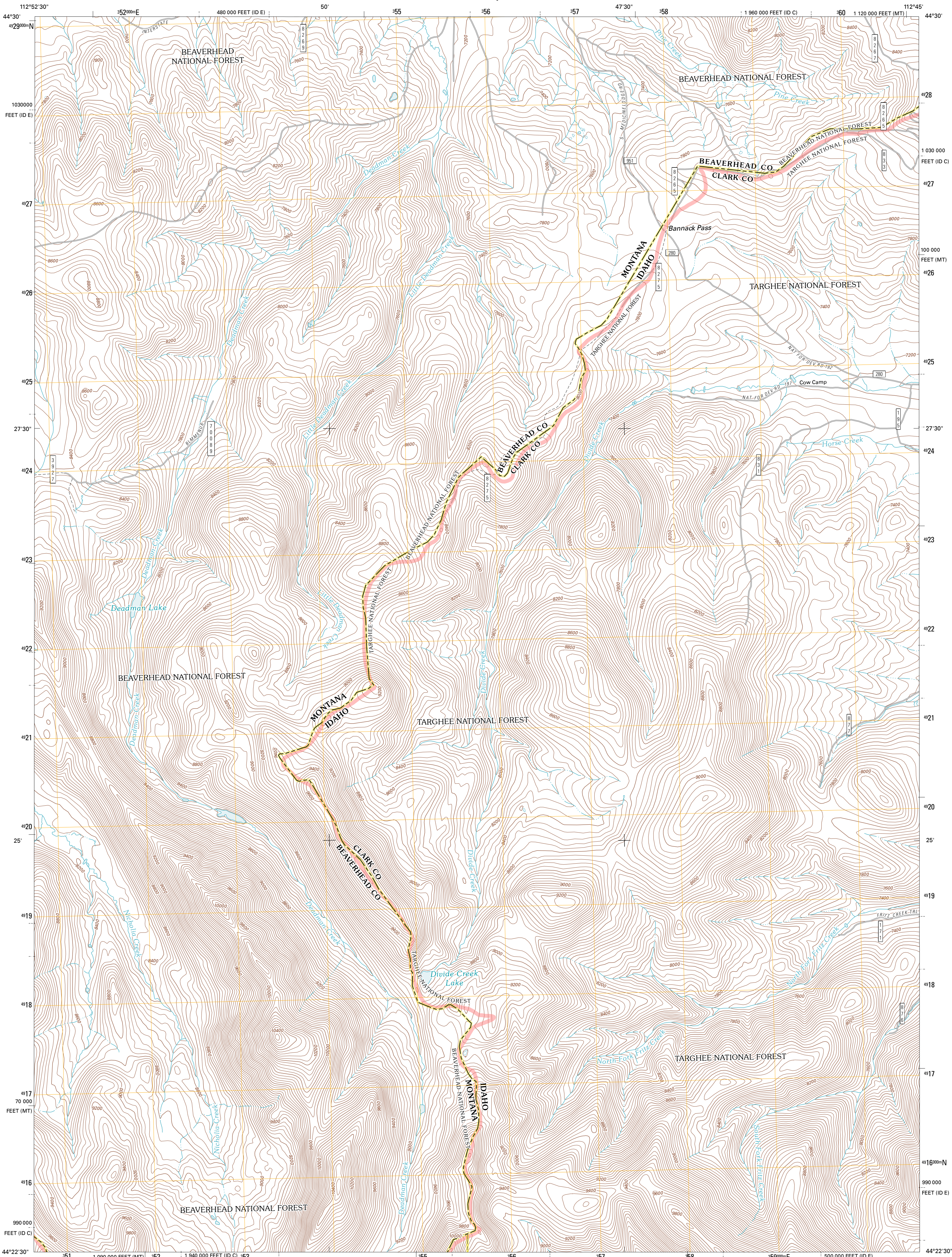

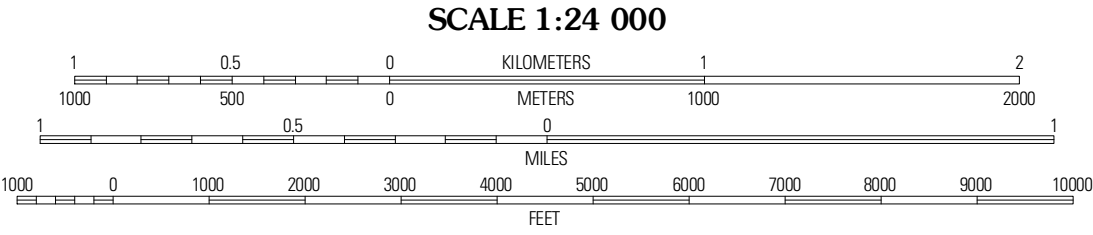
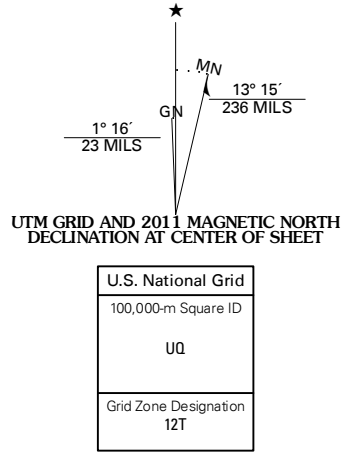


DEADMAN LAKE QUADRANGLE
