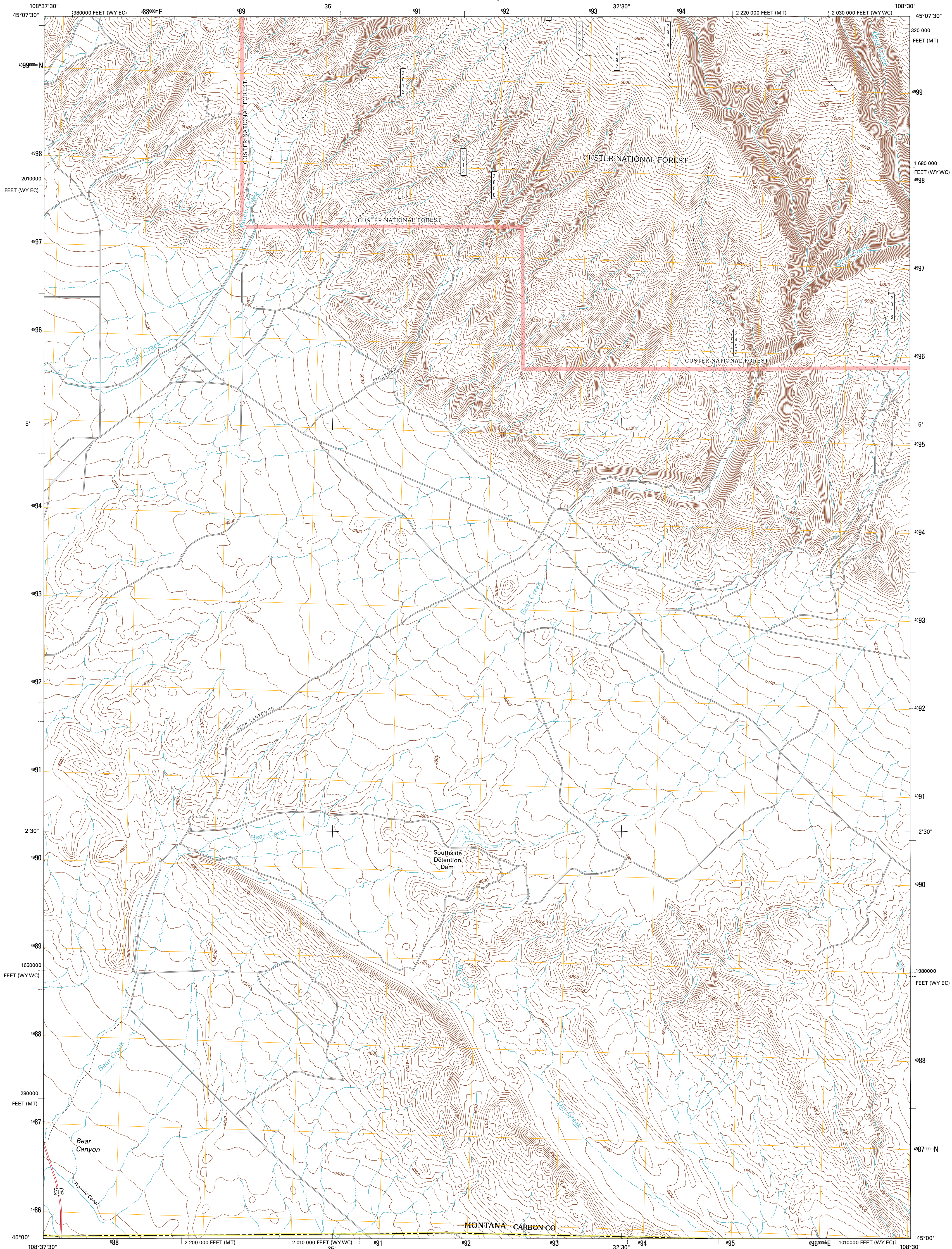

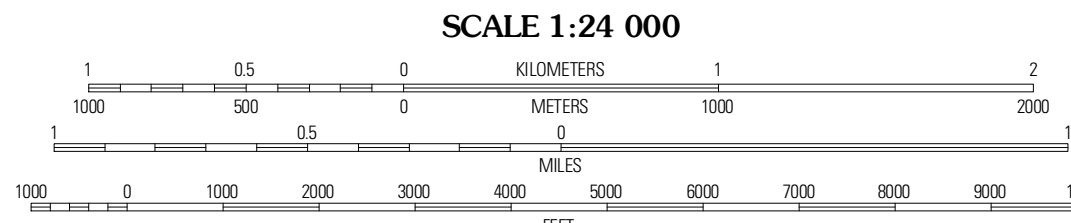
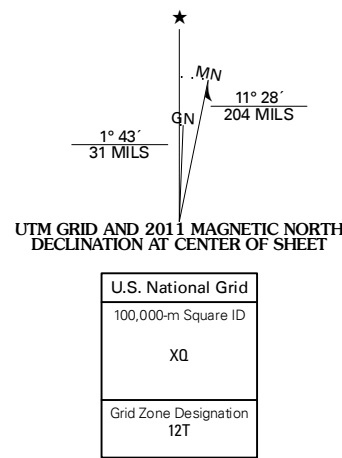


BEAR CANYON QUADRANGLE

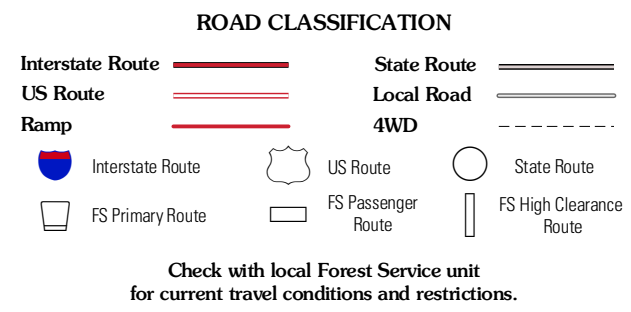
