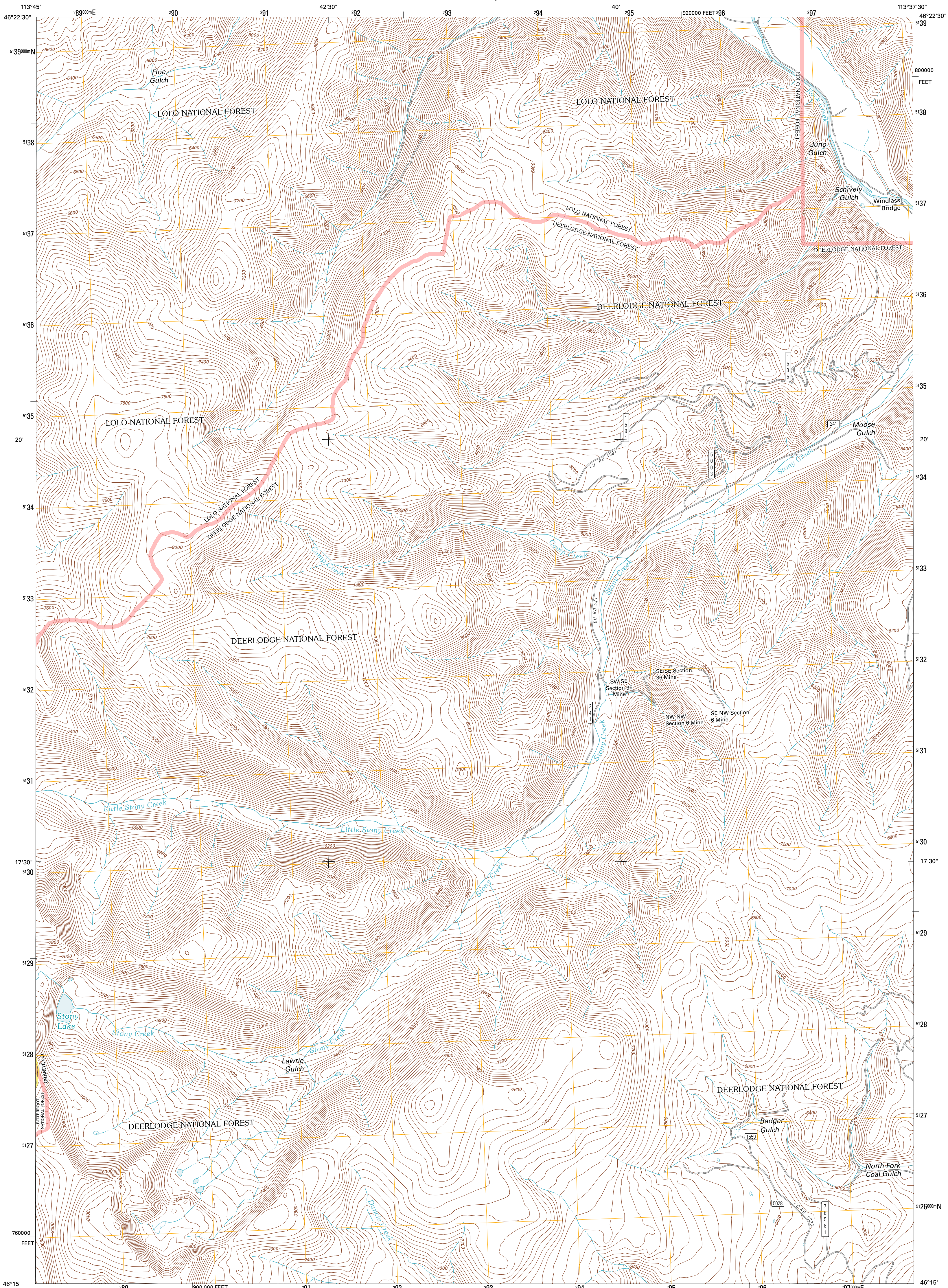

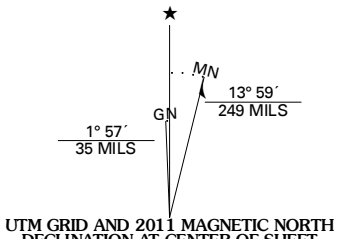


STONY CREEK QUADRANGLE

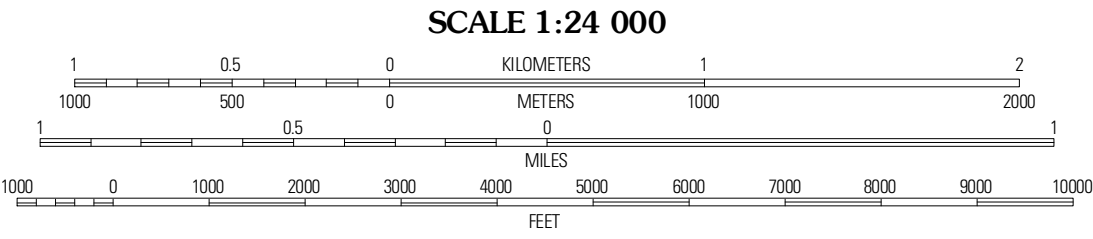

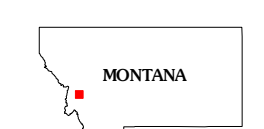

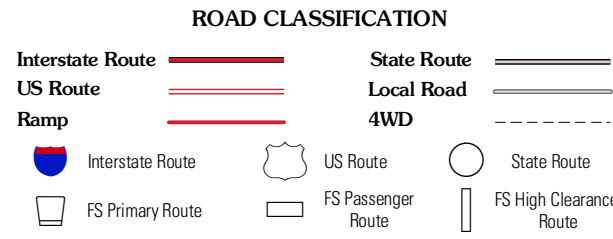
