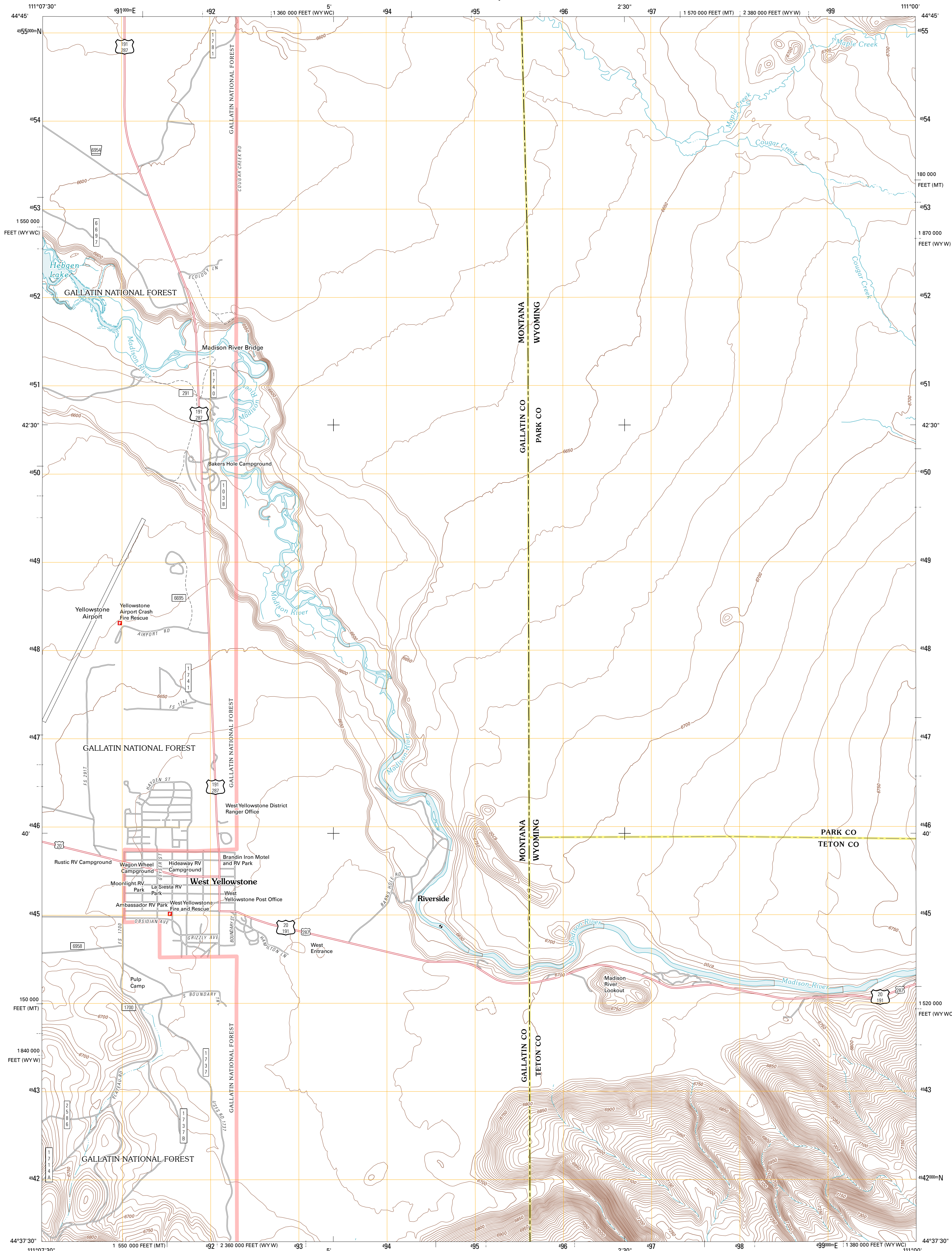

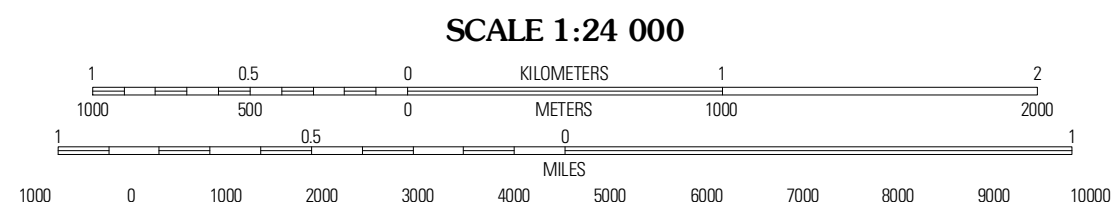
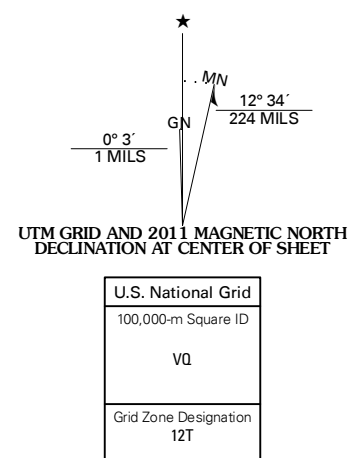


WEST YELLOWSTONE QUADRANGLE
