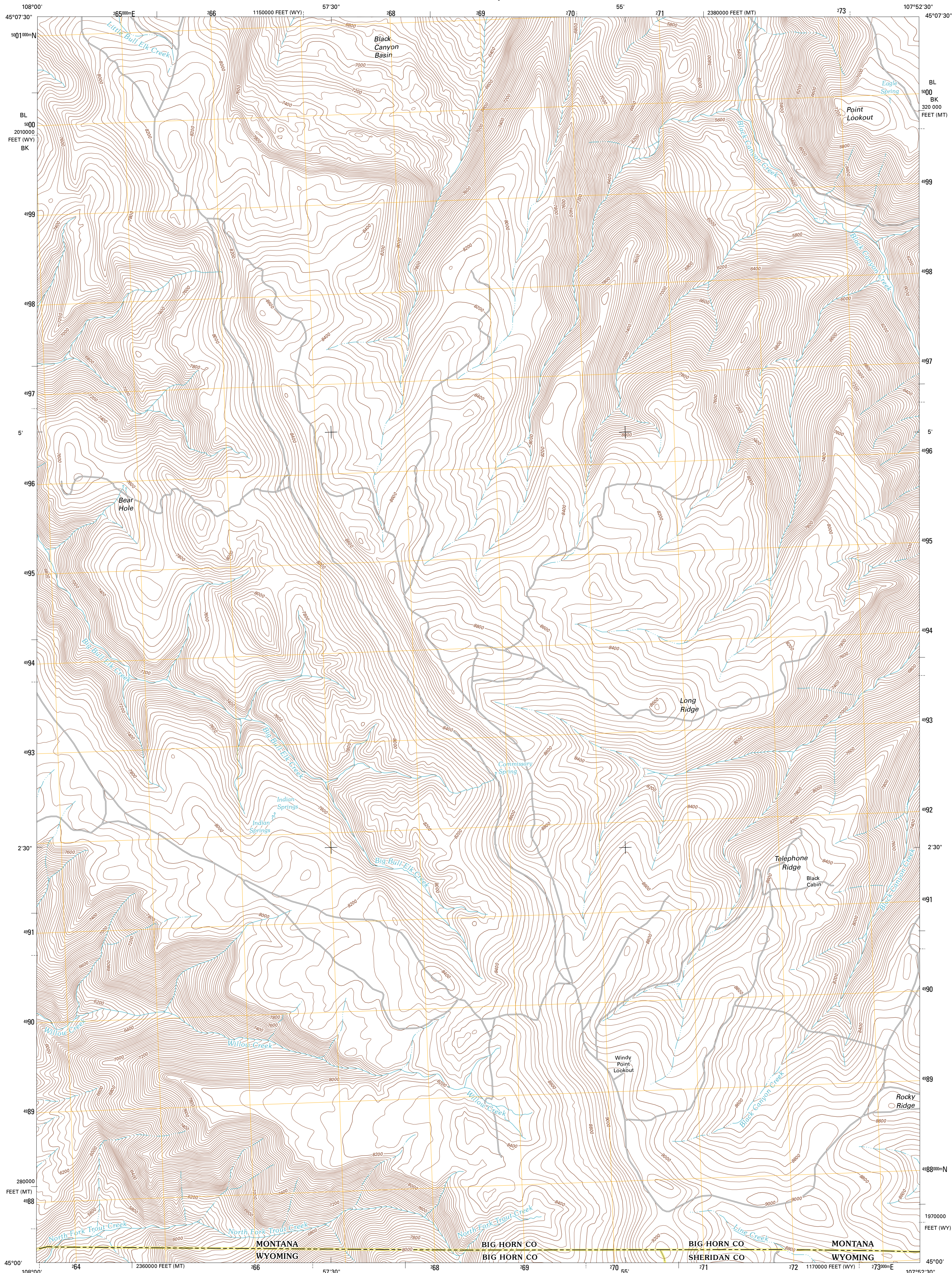

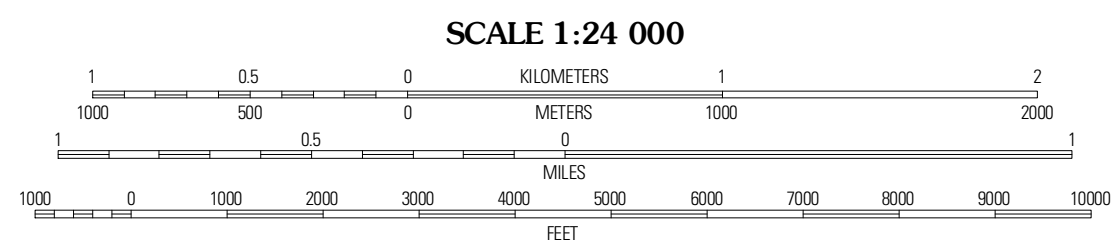
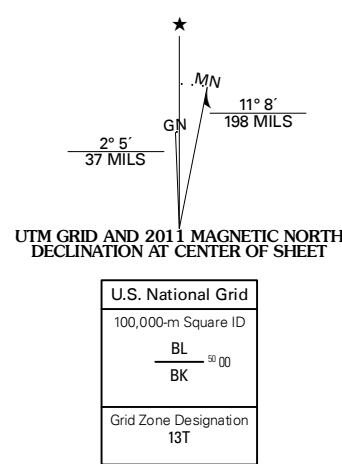


BEAR HOLE QUADRANGLE

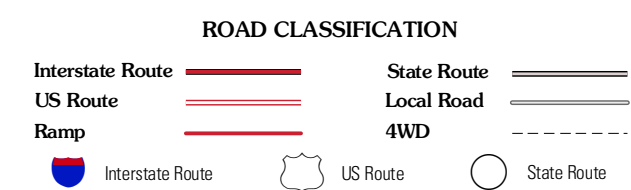
