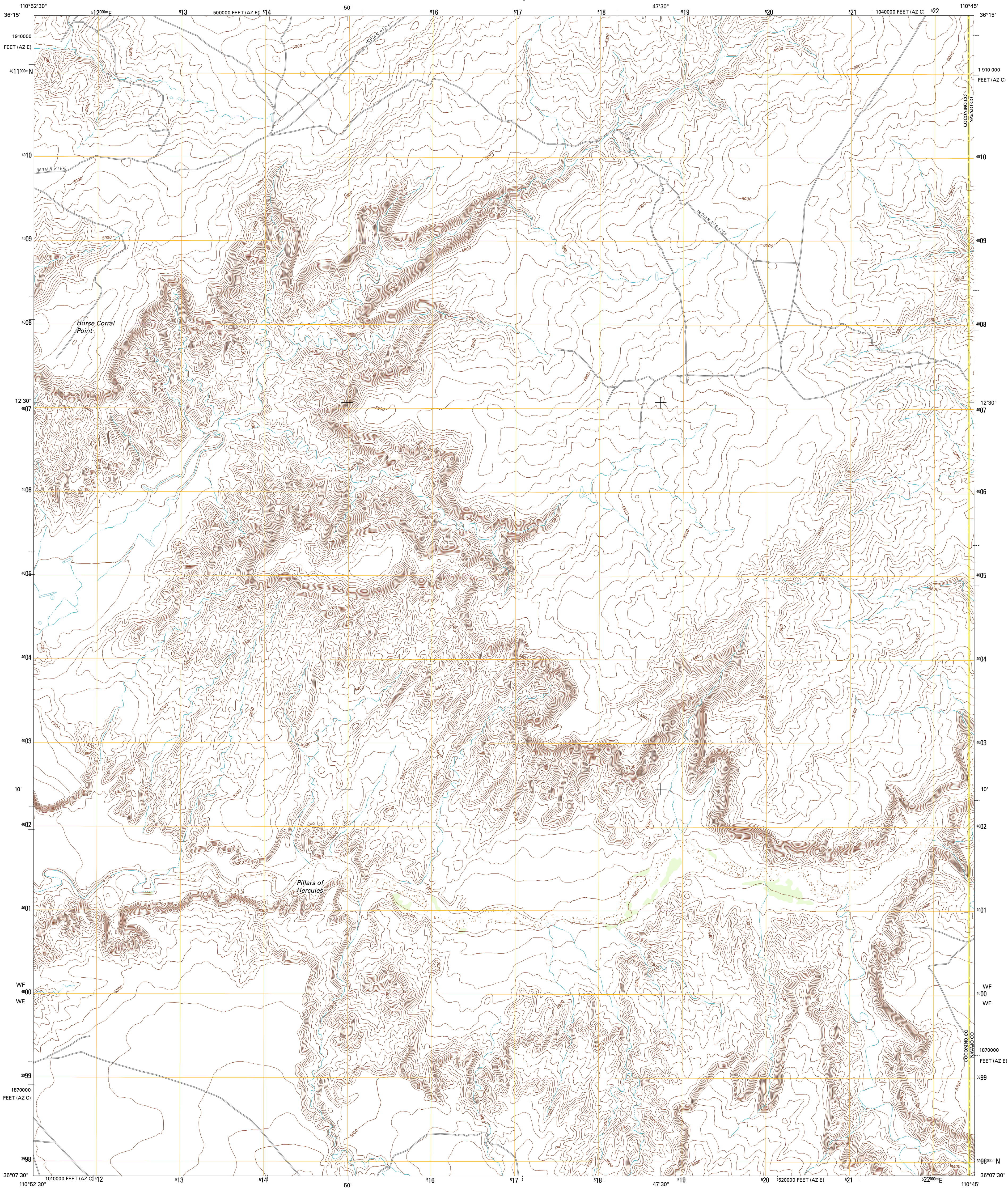

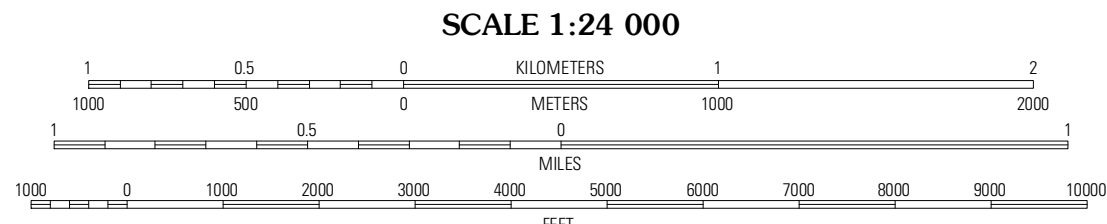
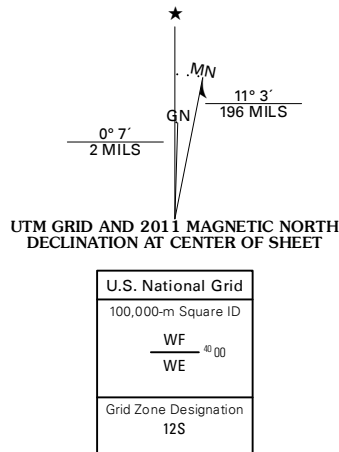


PILLARS OF HERCULES QUADRANGLE

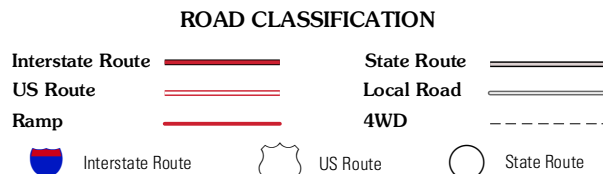
