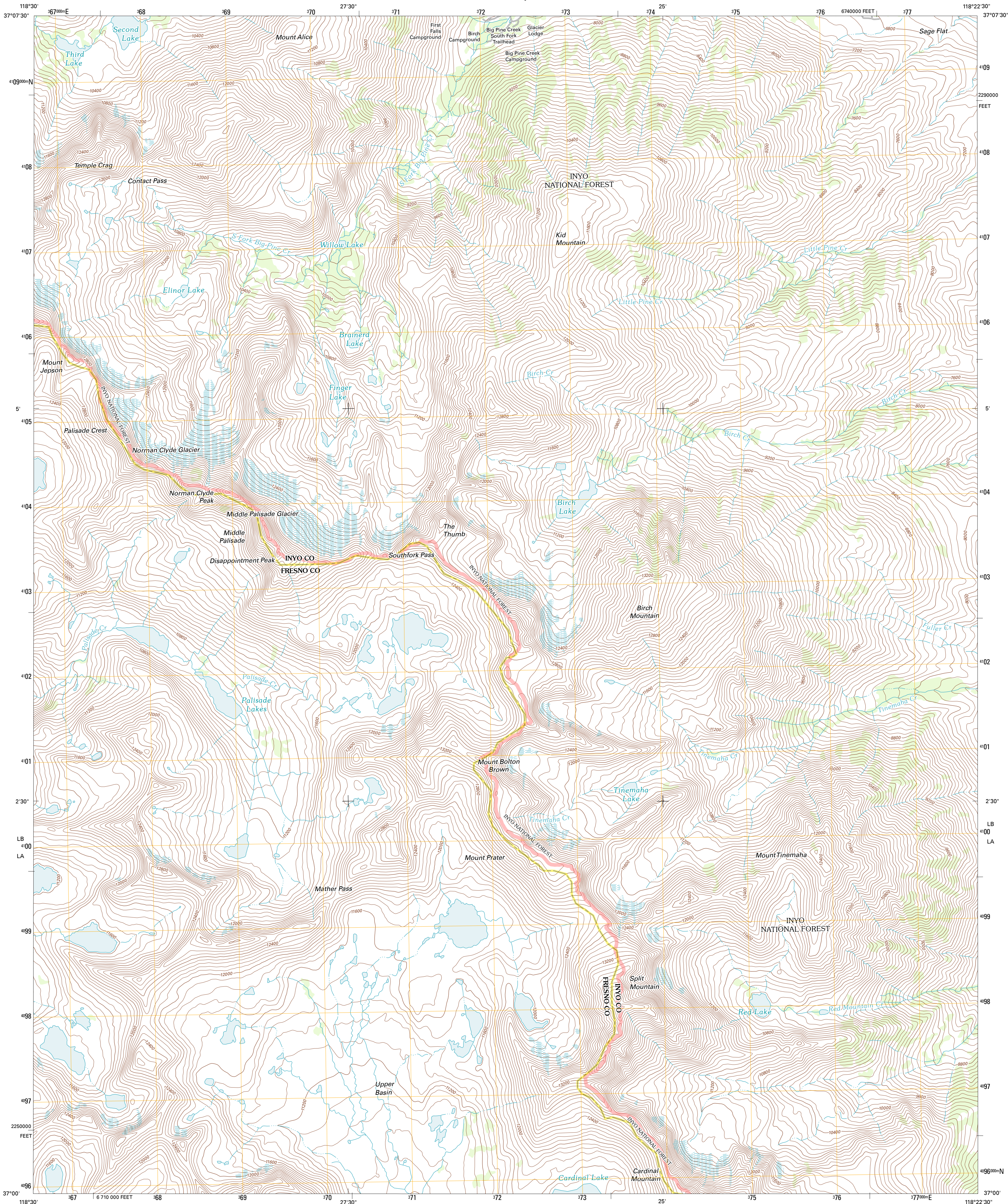

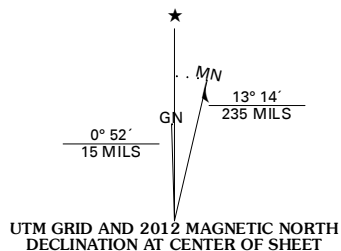


SPLIT MOUNTAIN QUADRANGLE

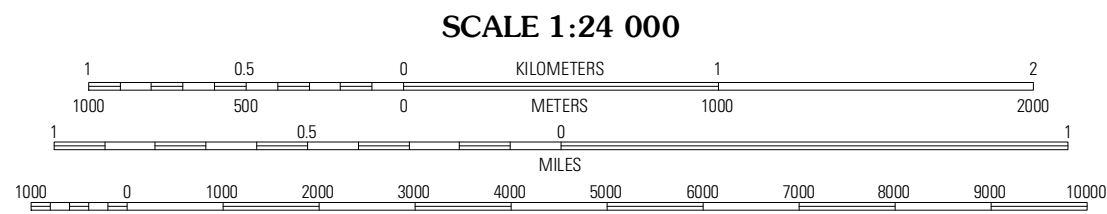
