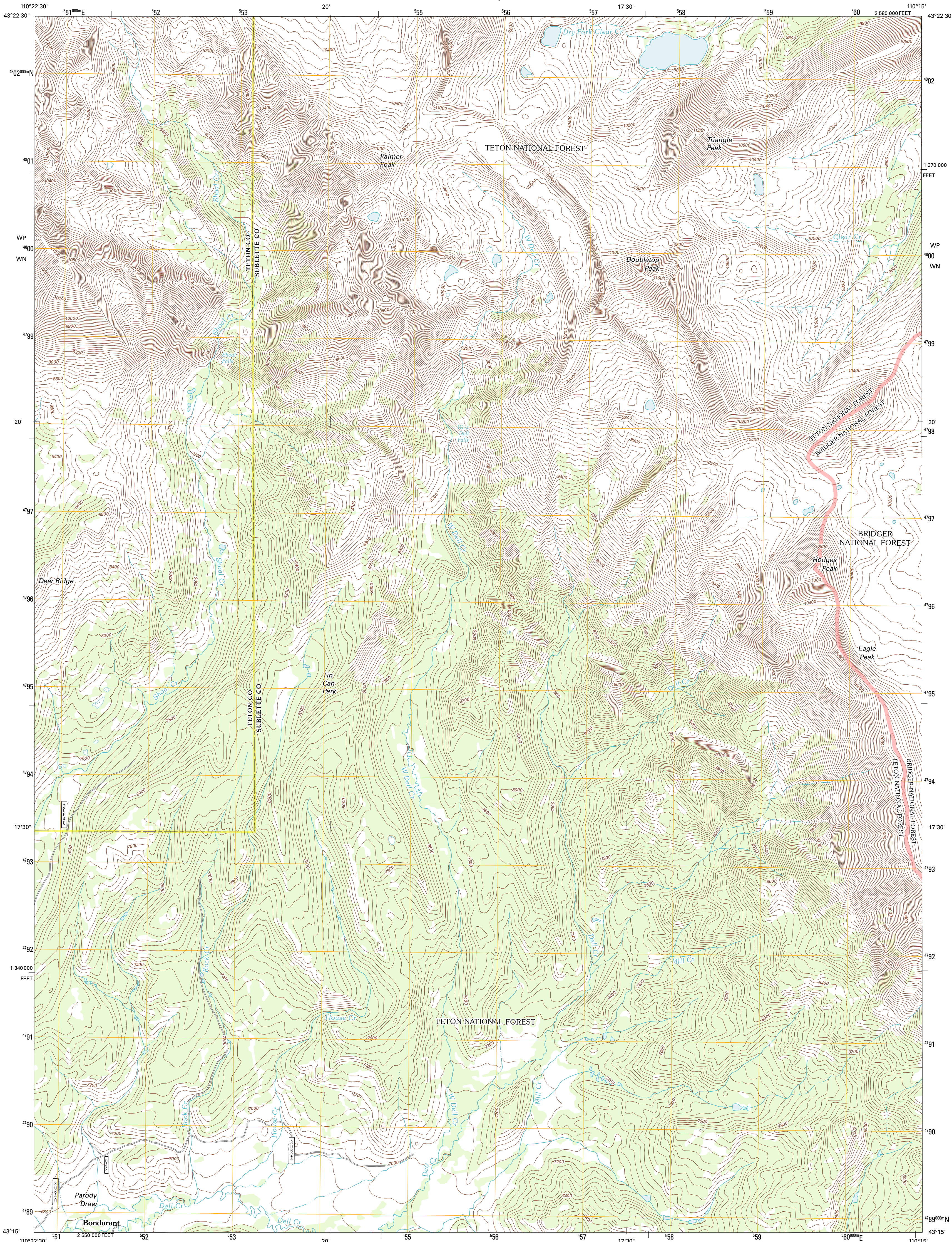

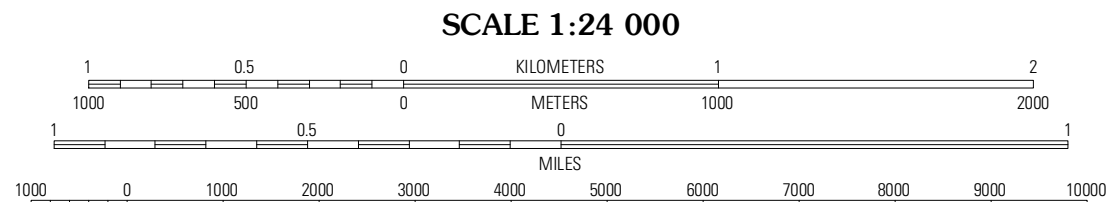
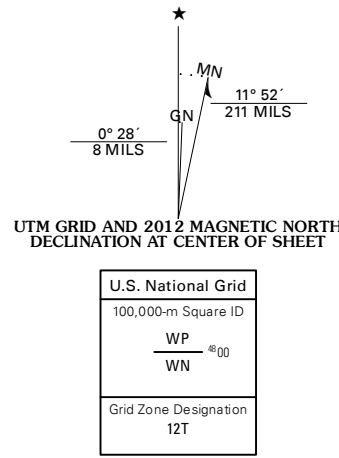


DOUBLETOP PEAK QUADRANGLE

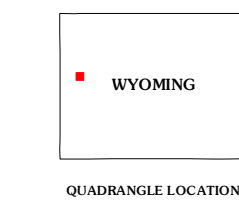

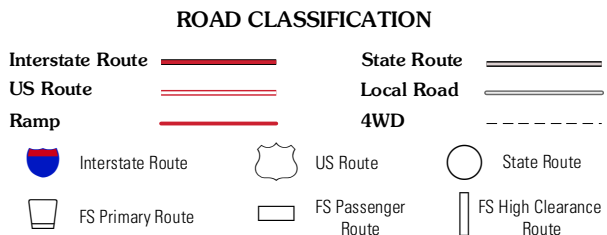
