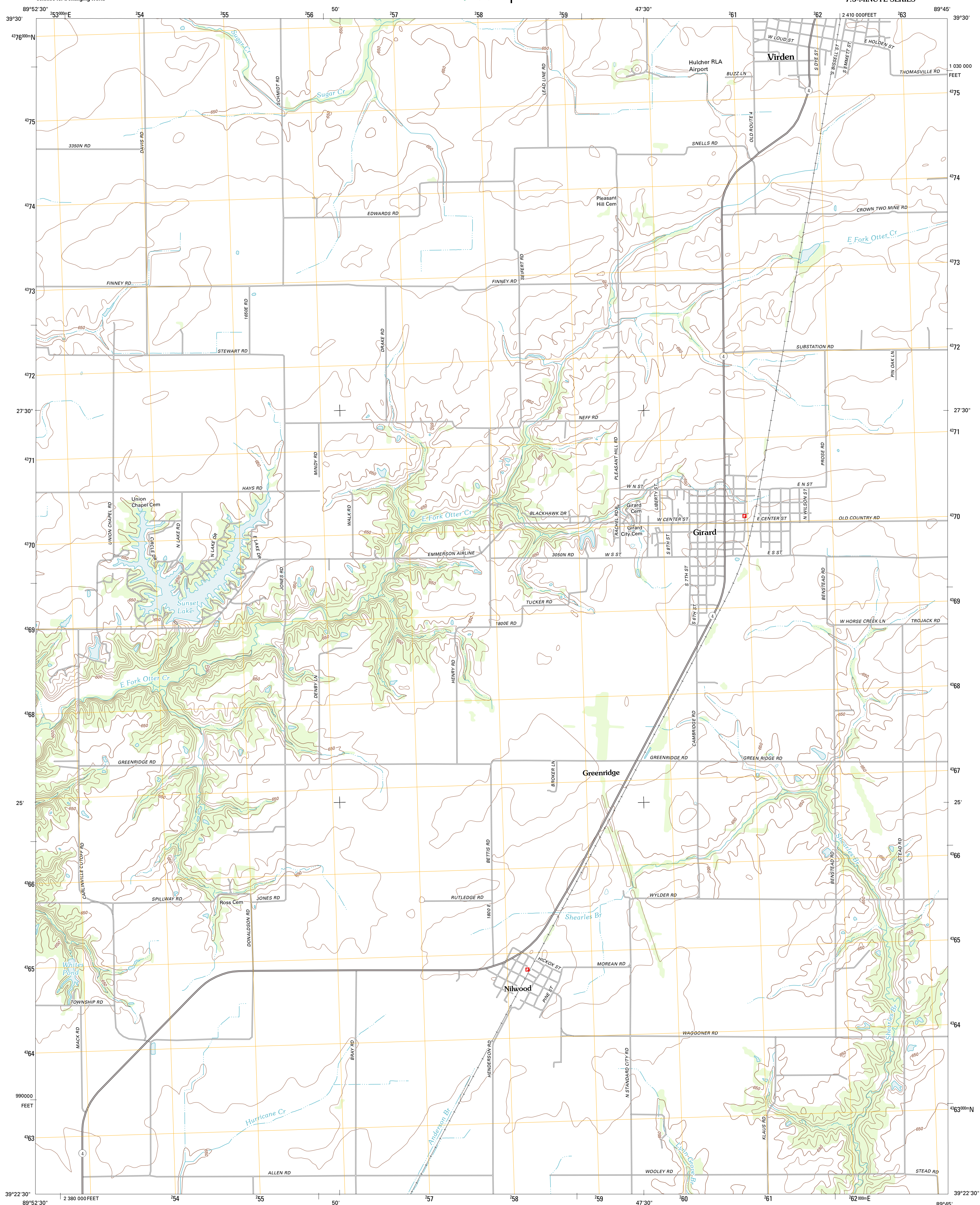




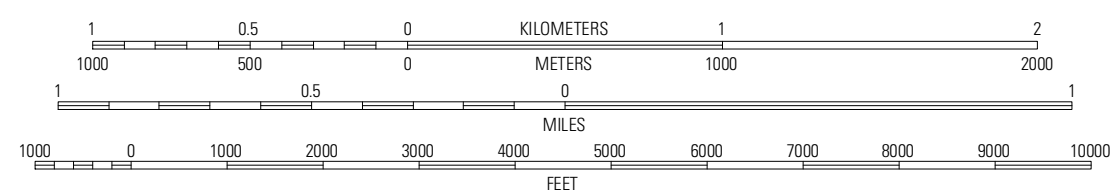

The diagram illustrates the relationship between Magnetic North (MN) and Grid North (GN). A vertical line represents the meridian. A star at the top indicates true north. MN is marked on the line, and GN is marked below it. The angle between the true north line and MN is $1^{\circ} 28'$, with a distance of 26 MILS indicated. The angle between MN and GN is $1^{\circ} 47'$, with a distance of 32 MILS indicated.
