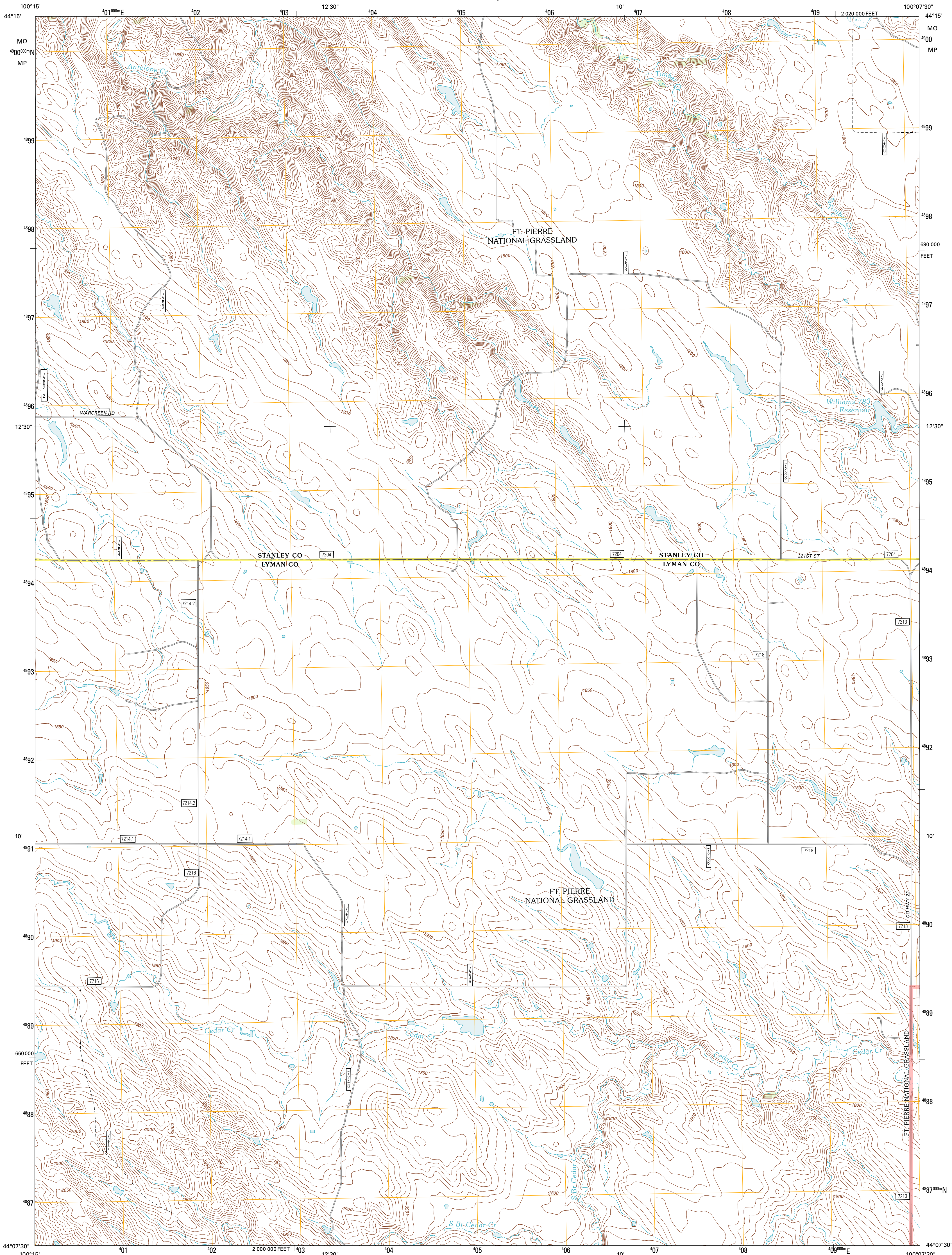

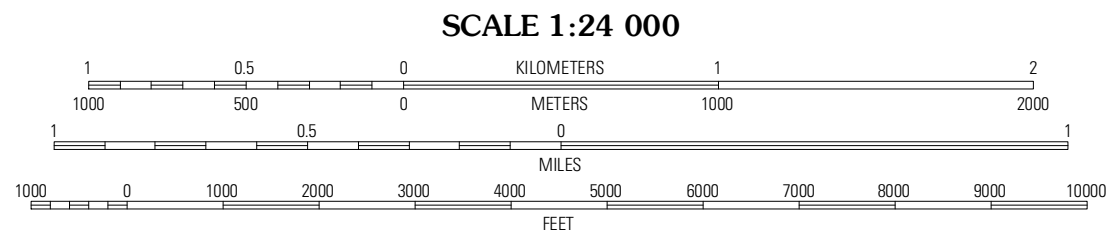
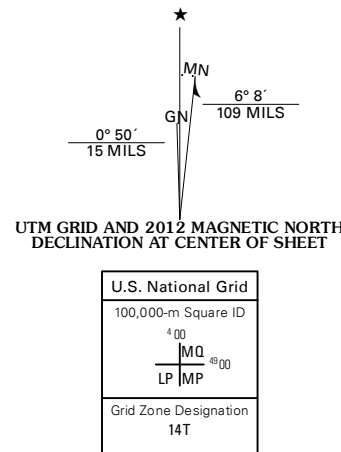


FORT GEORGE BUTTE NW QUADRANGLE
