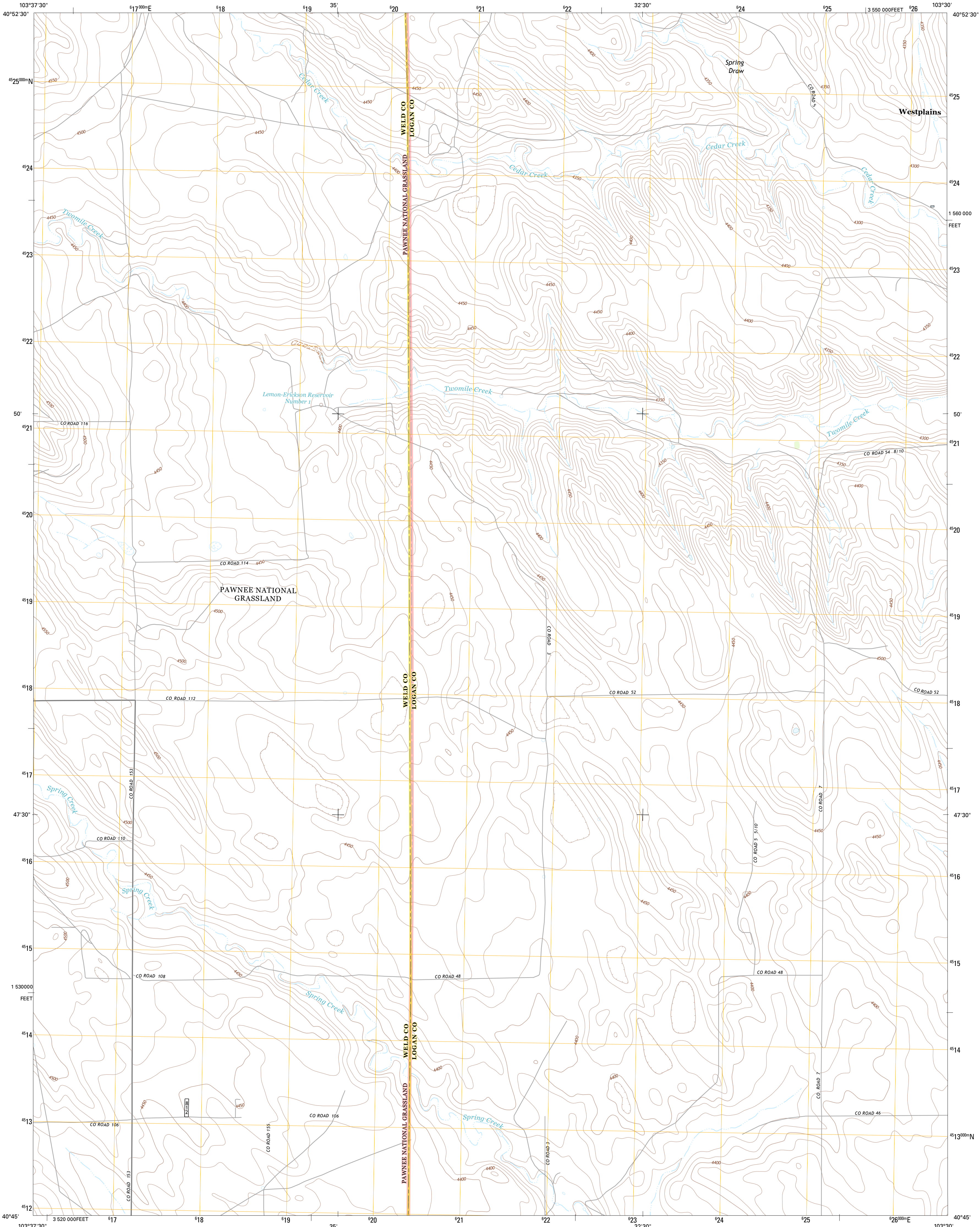

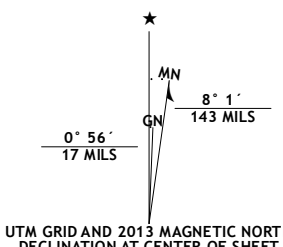


AVALO SE QUADRANGLE

7.5-MINUTE SERIES

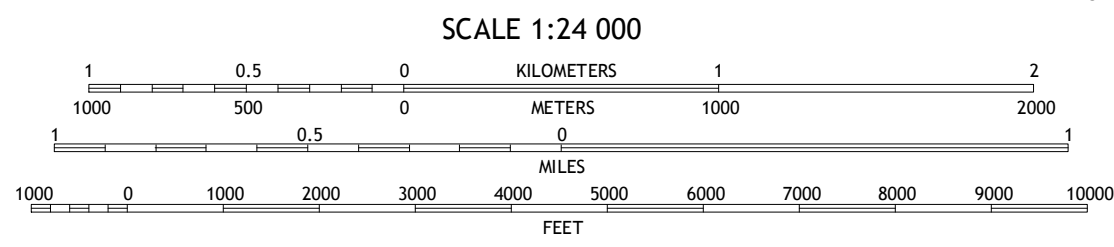

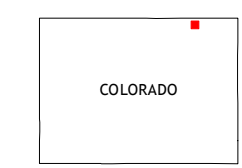
