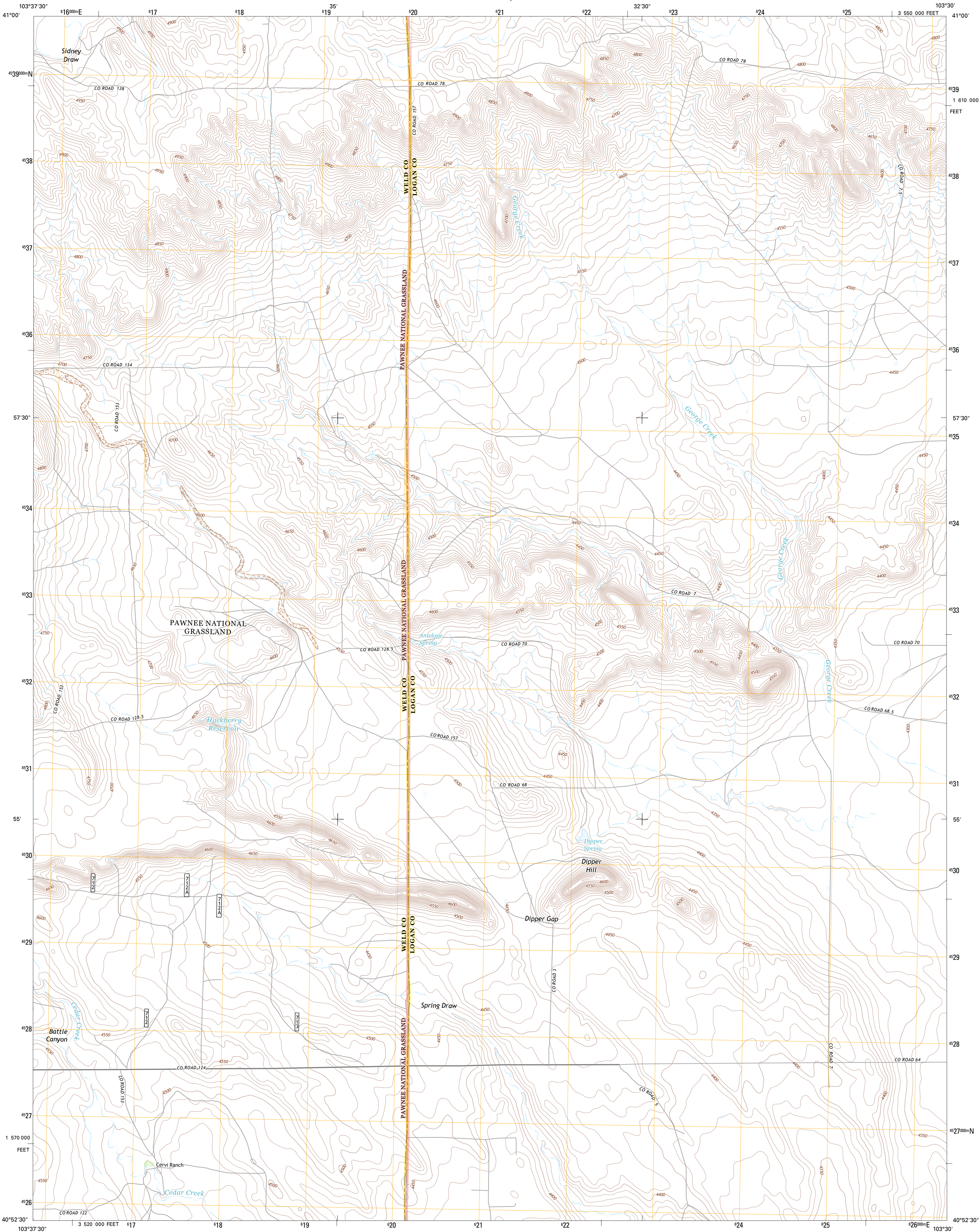

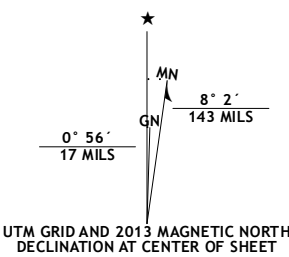


DIPPER SPRING QUADRANGLE

7.5-MINUTE SERIES

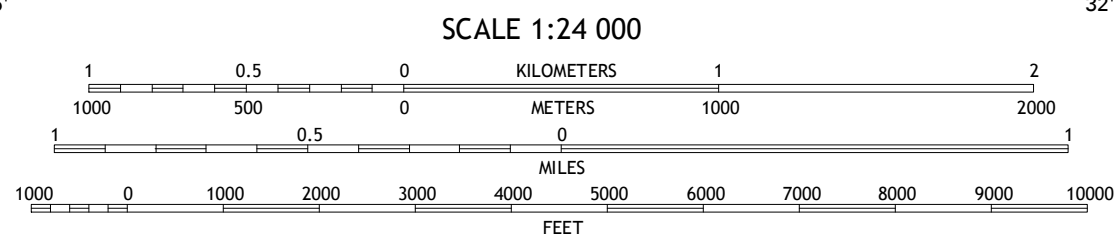

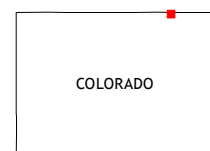
