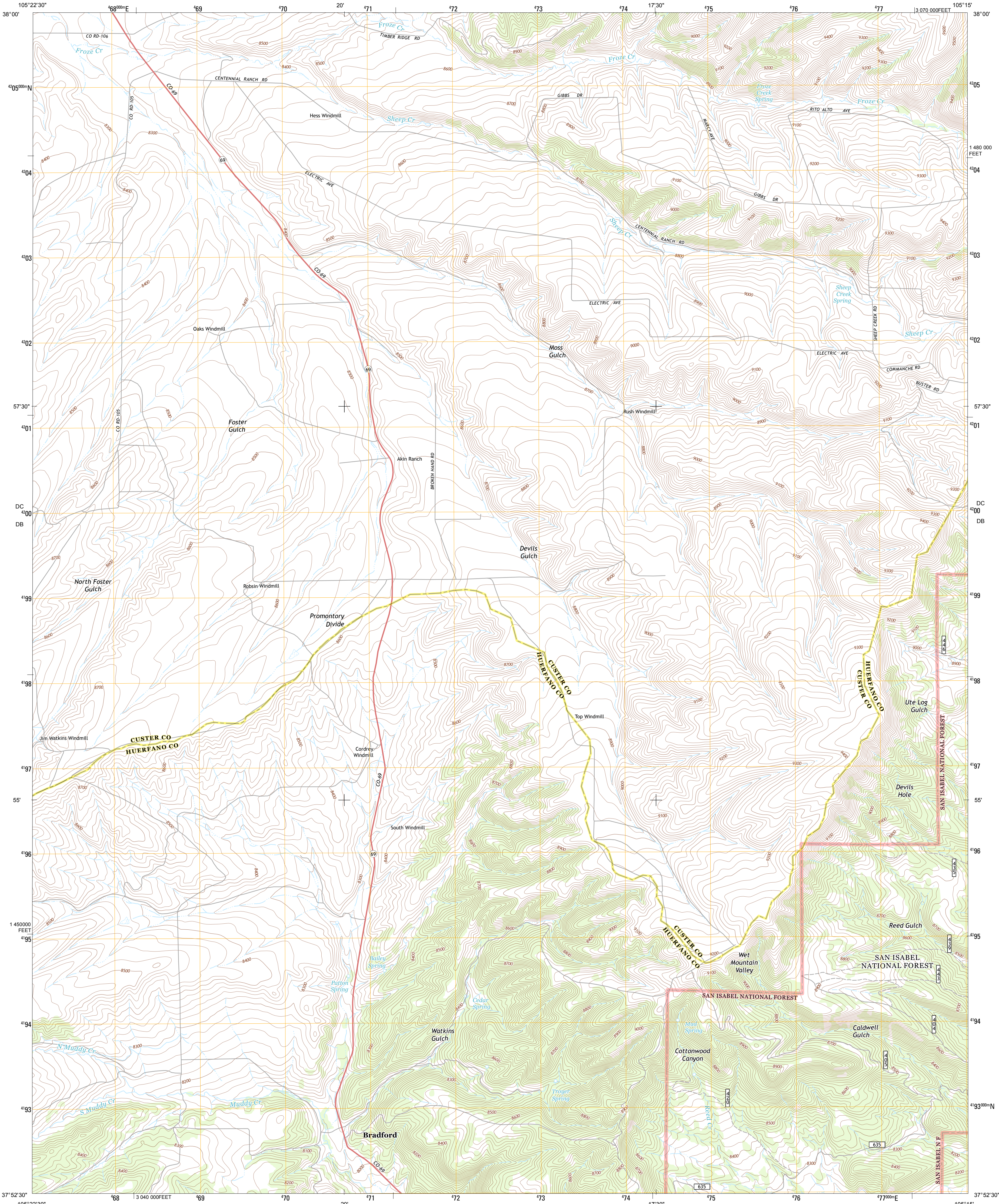

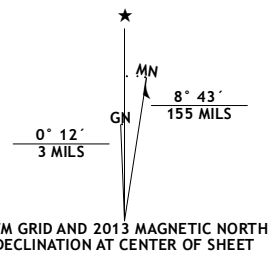


DEVILS GULCH QUADRANGLE

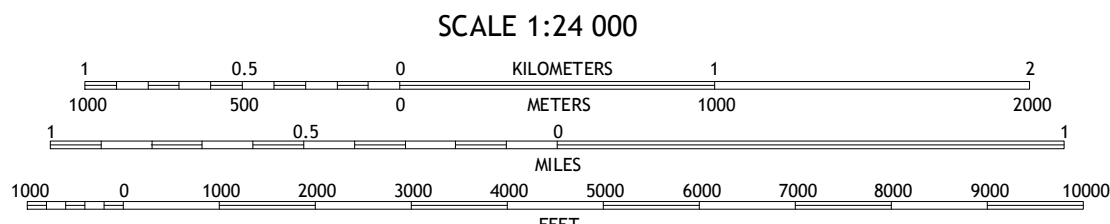

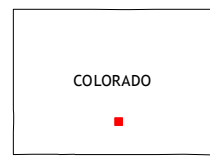

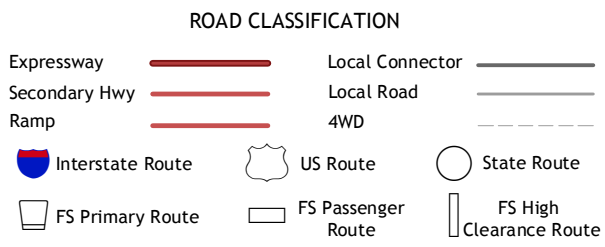
