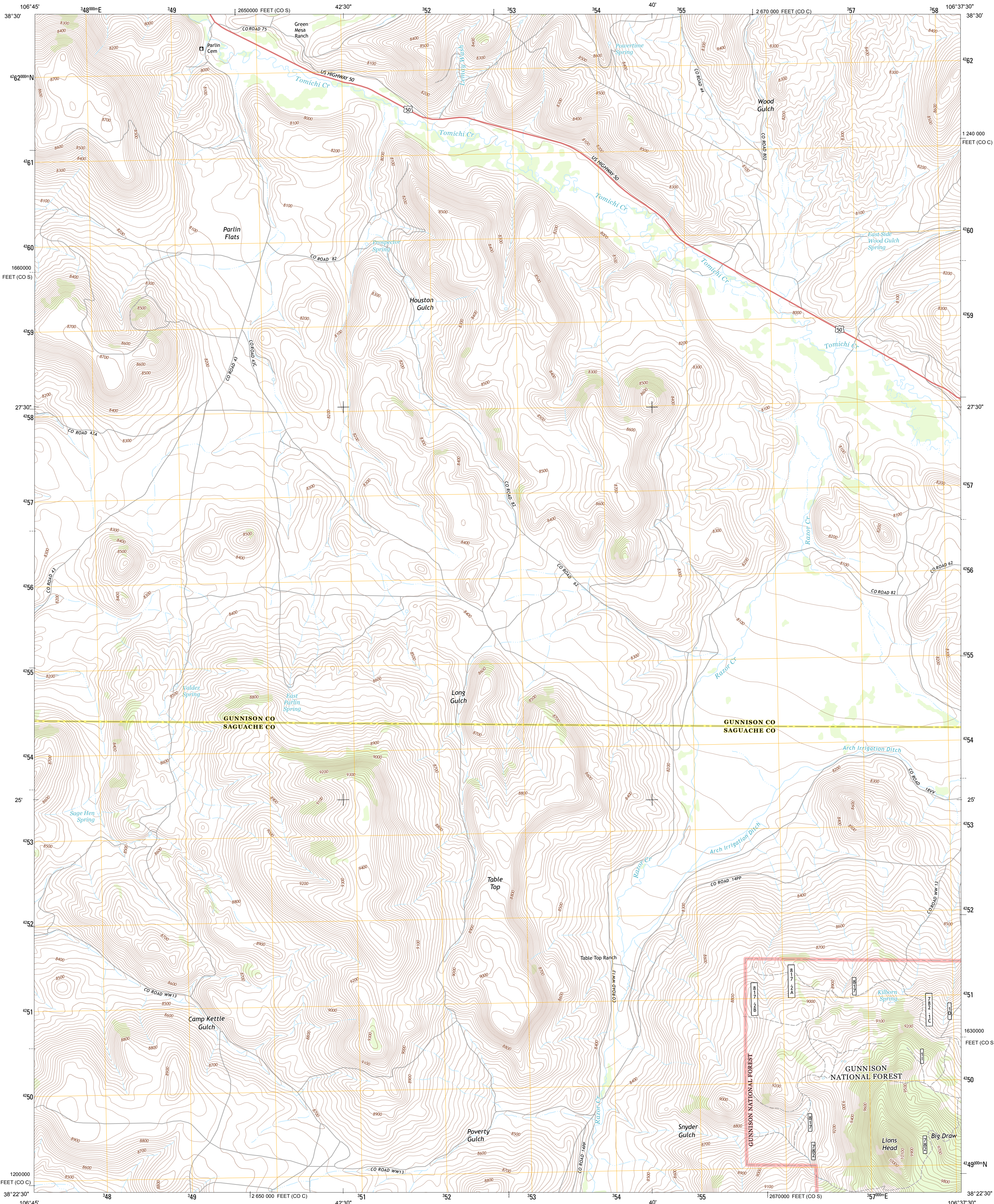

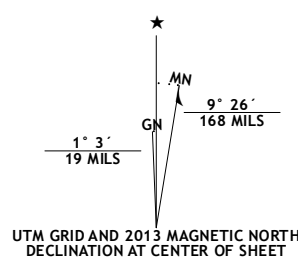


HOUSTON GULCH QUADRANGLE

7.5-MINUTE SERIES

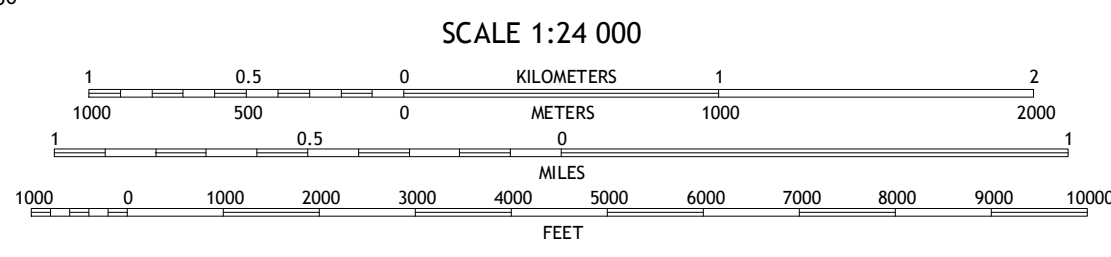

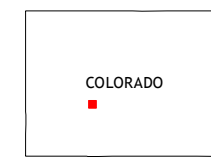
