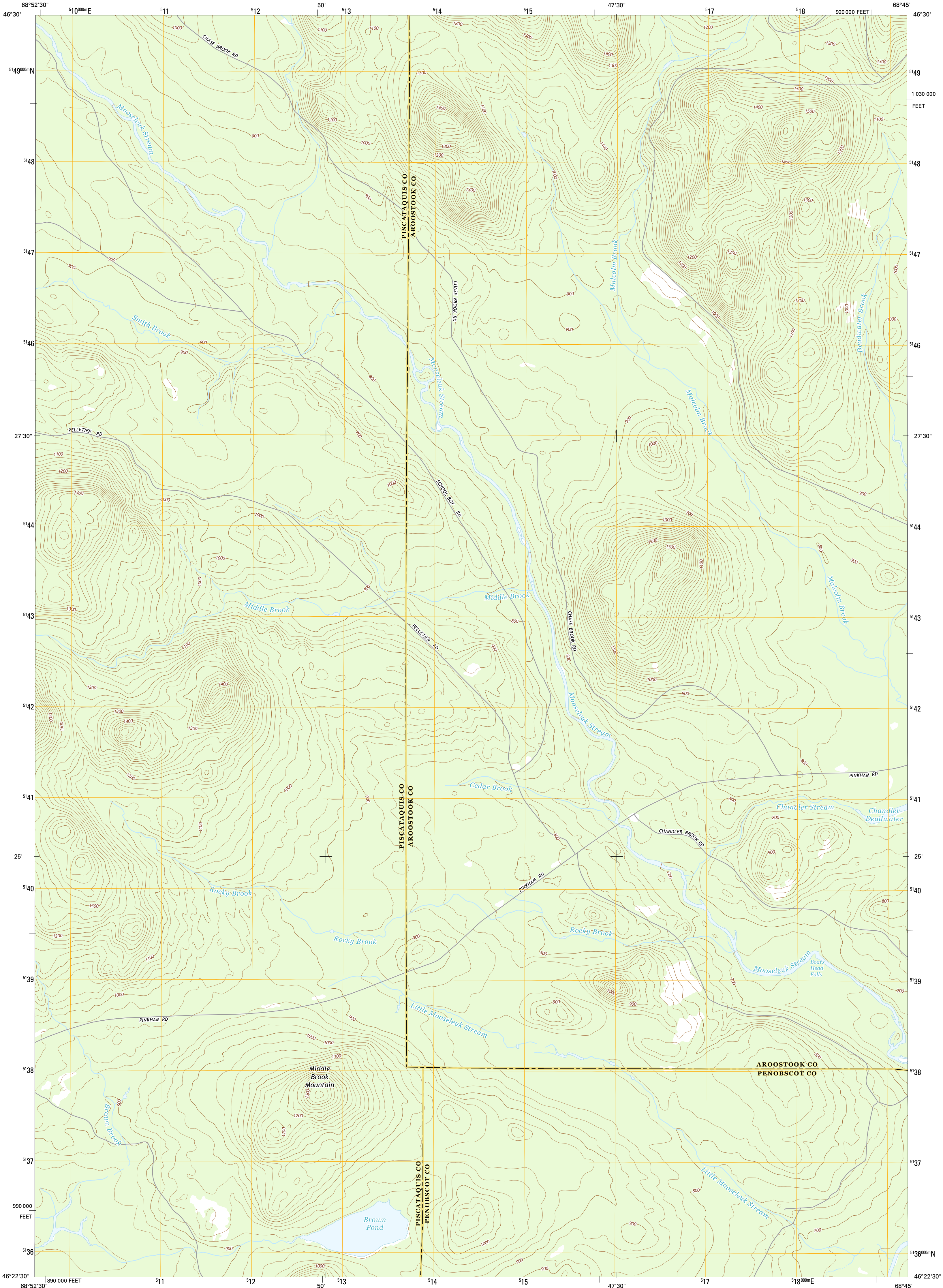

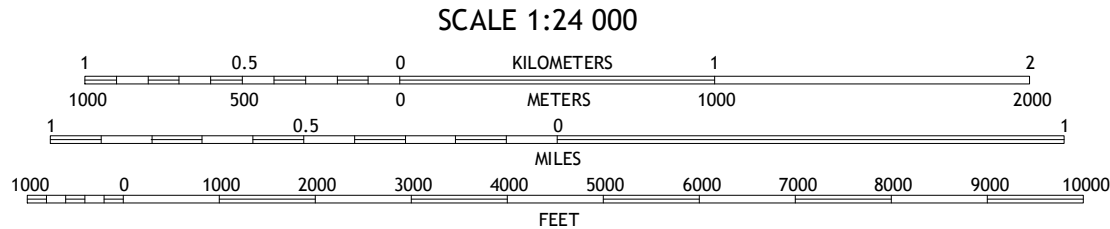
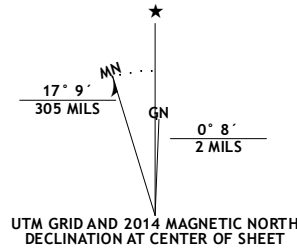
MIDDLE BROOK MOUNTAIN QUADRANGLE
