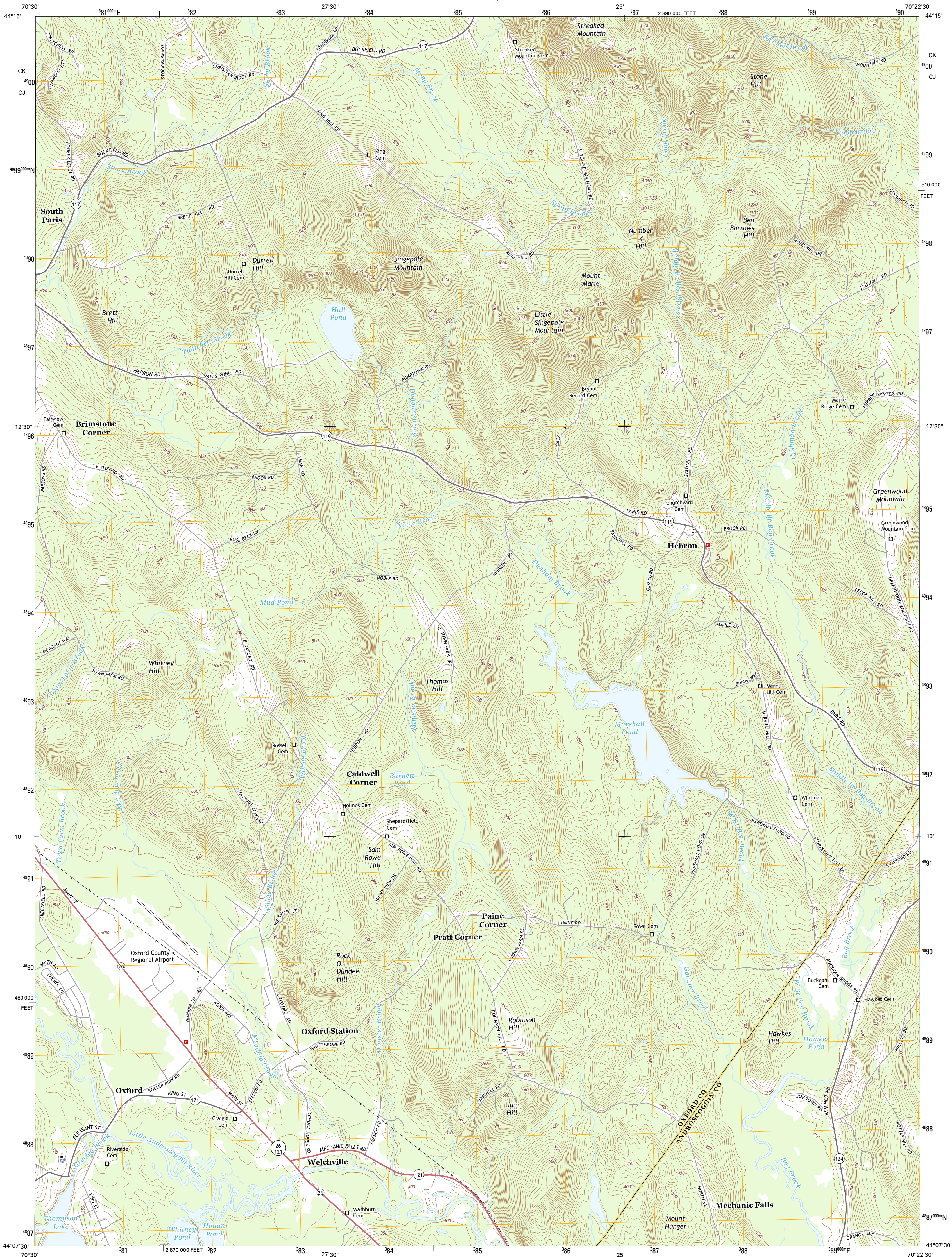

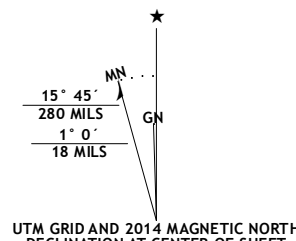


OXFORD QUADRANGLE

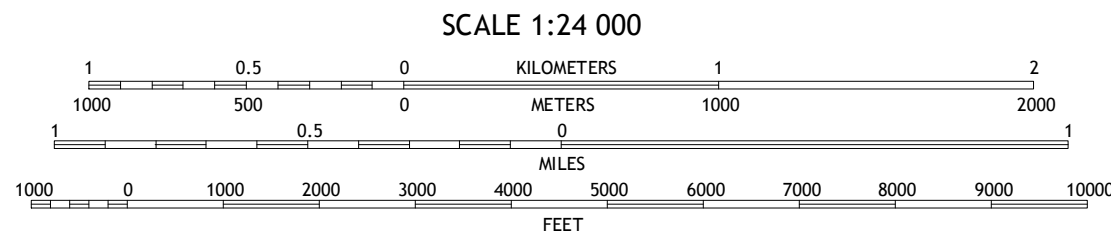
