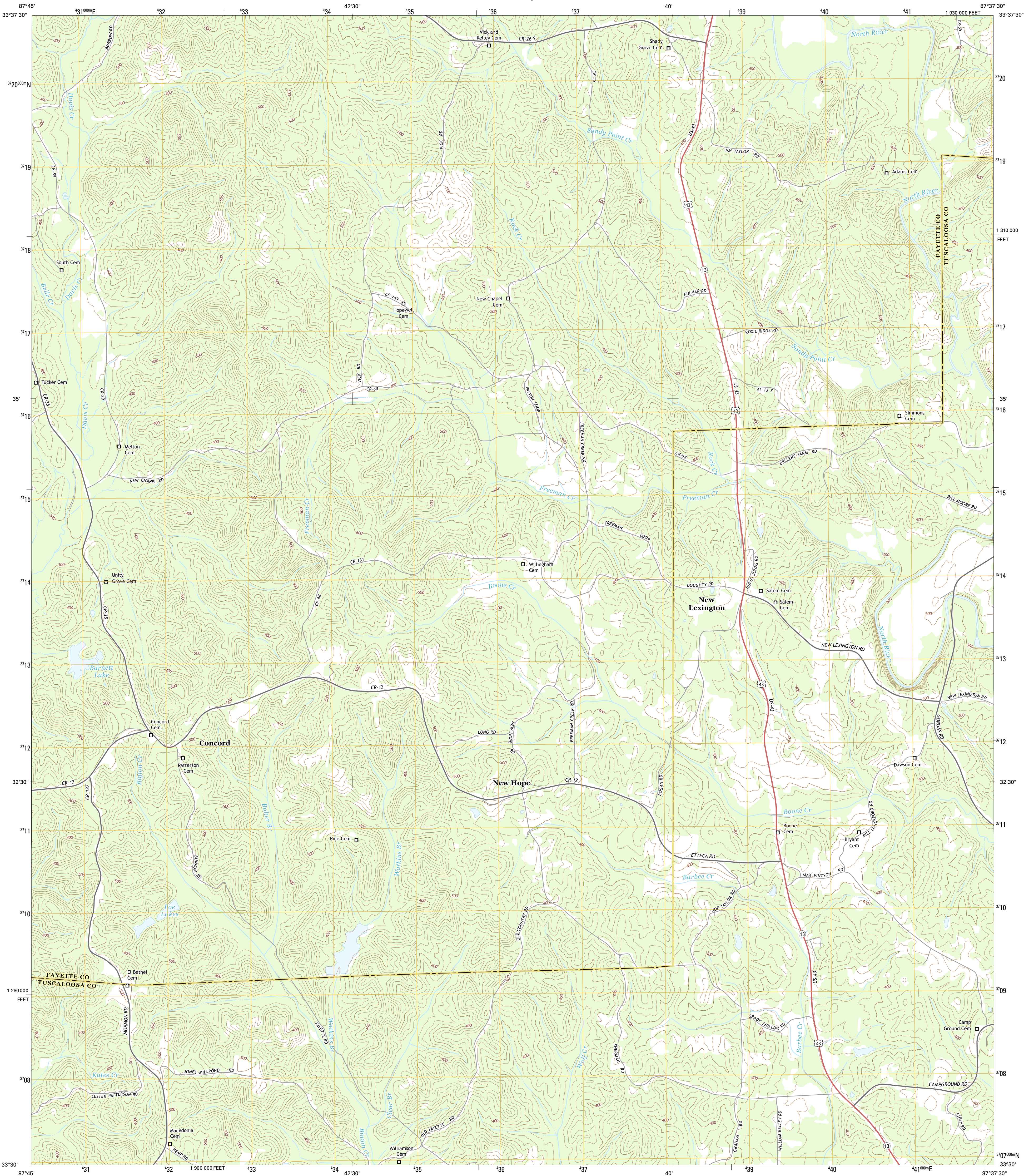

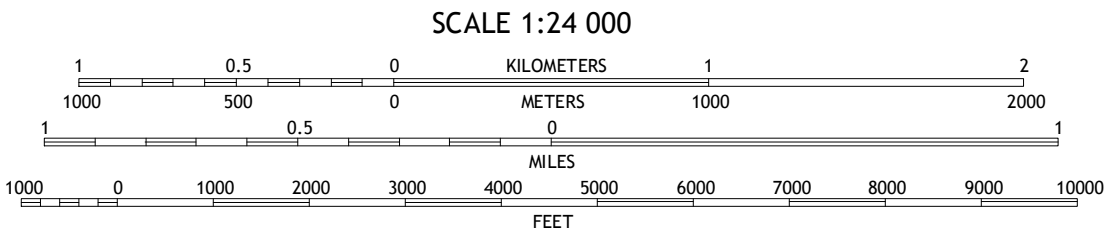


NEW LEXINGTON QUADRANGLE

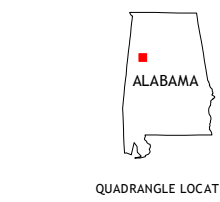
