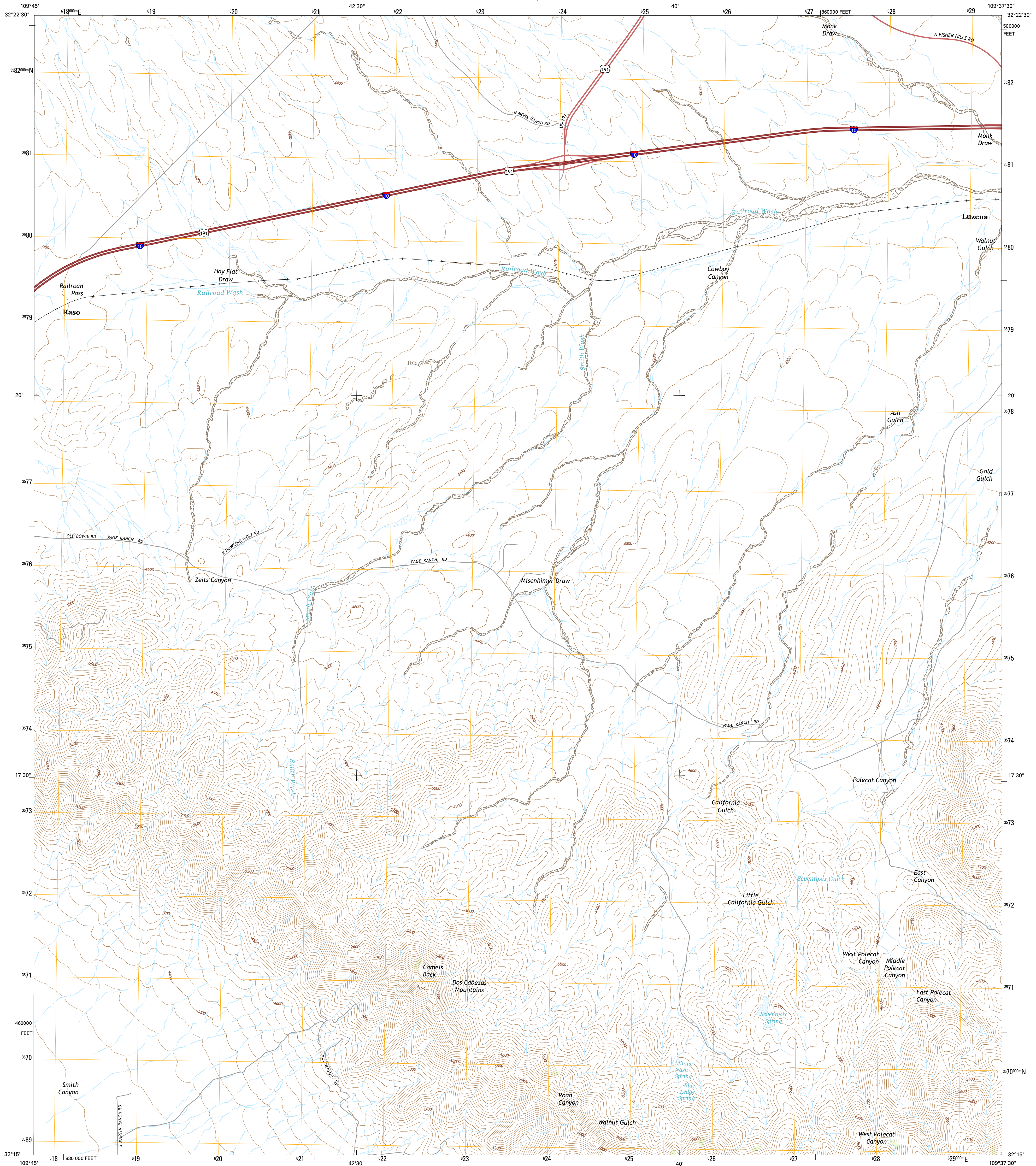

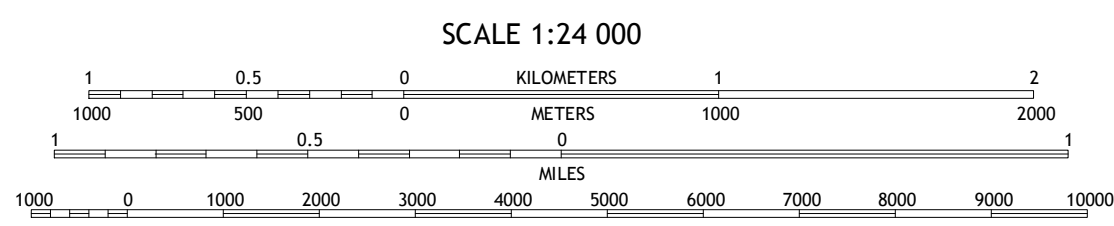

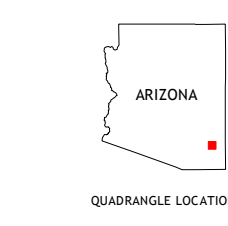
UTM GRID AND 2014 MAGNETIC NORTH
