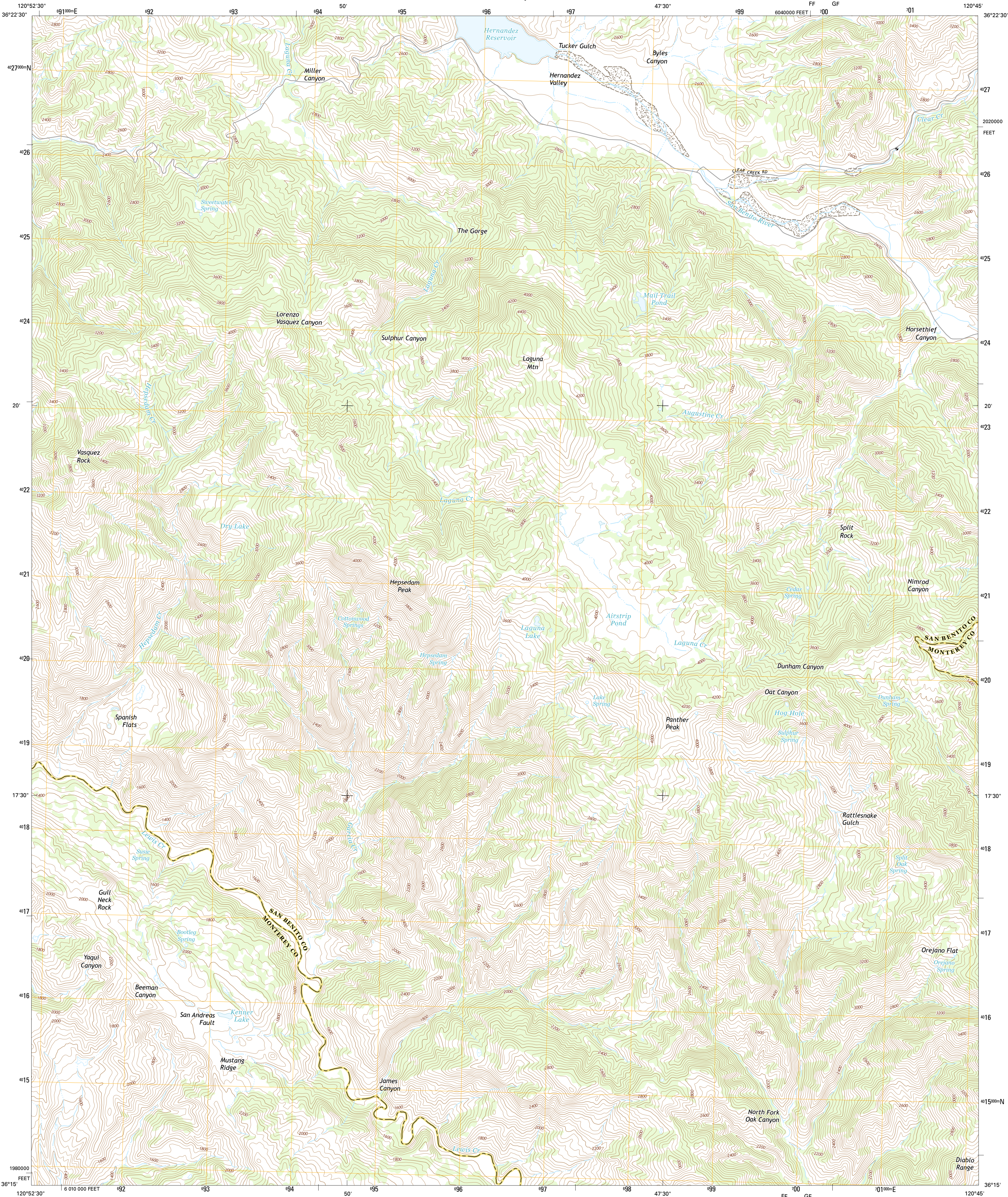

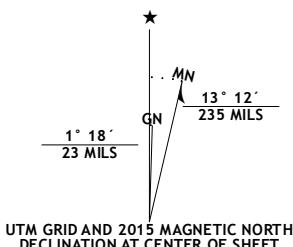
HEPSEDAM PEAK QUADRANGLE

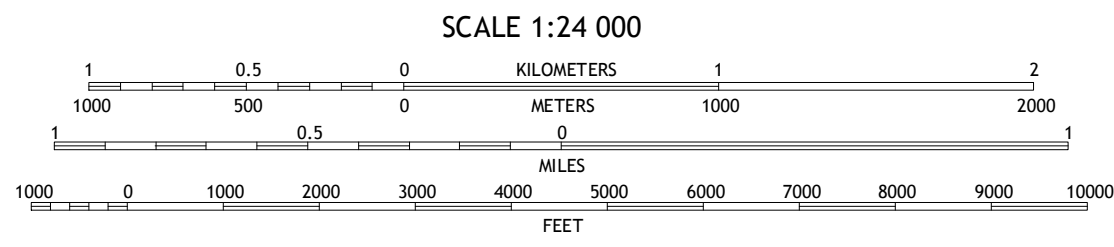
