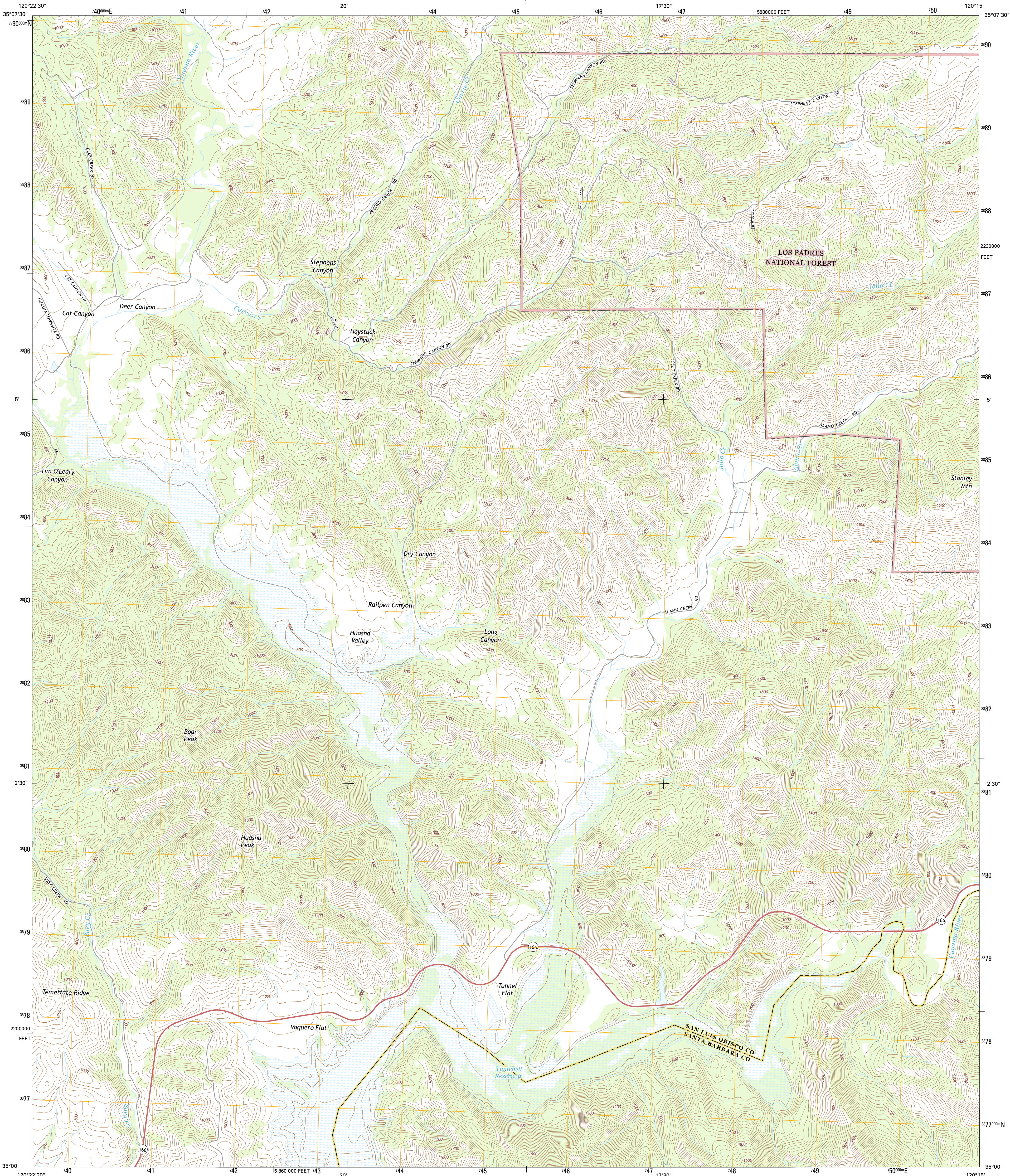

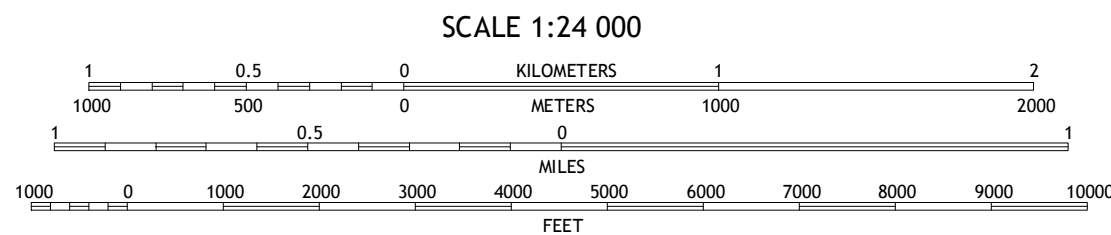
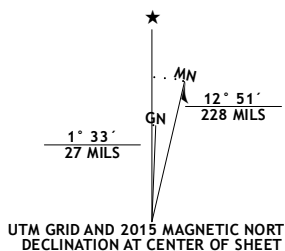
HUASNA PEAK QUADRANGLE

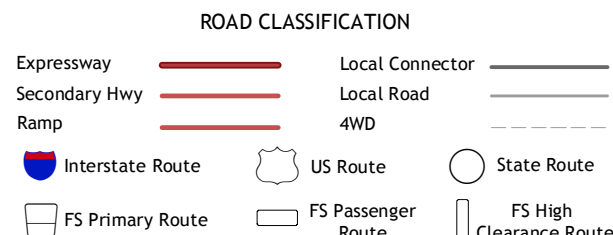
