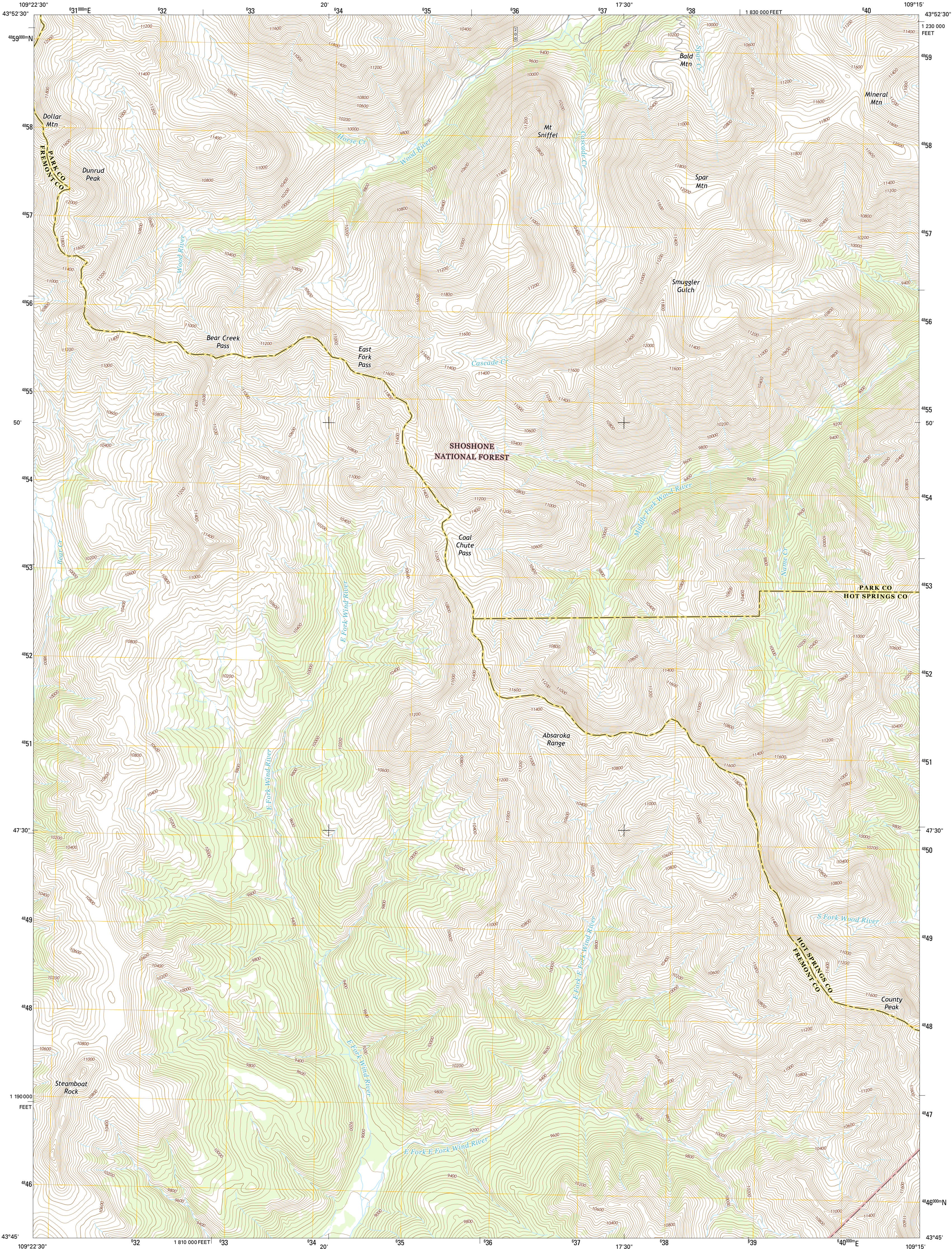

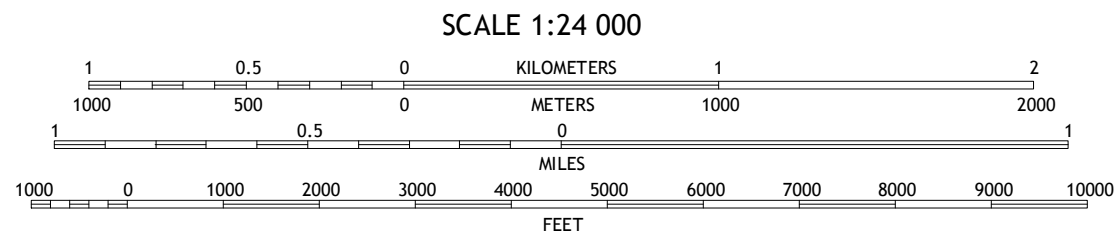
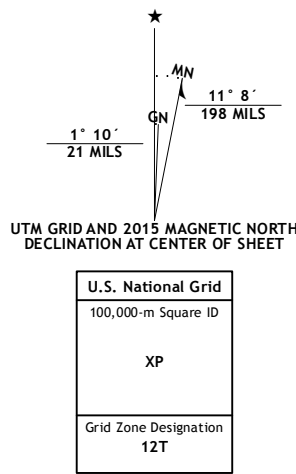
DUNRUD PEAK QUADRANGLE

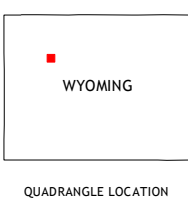
