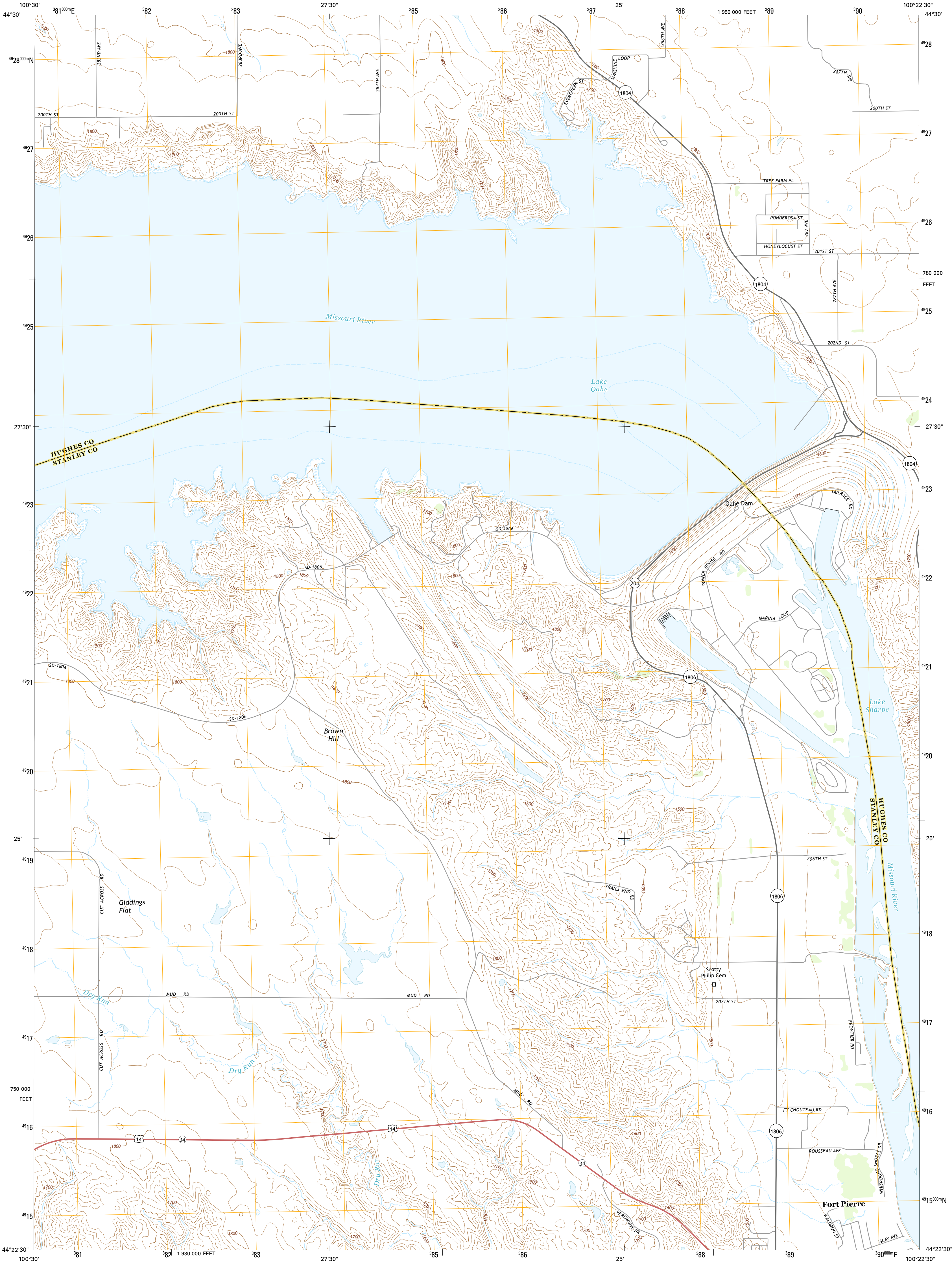

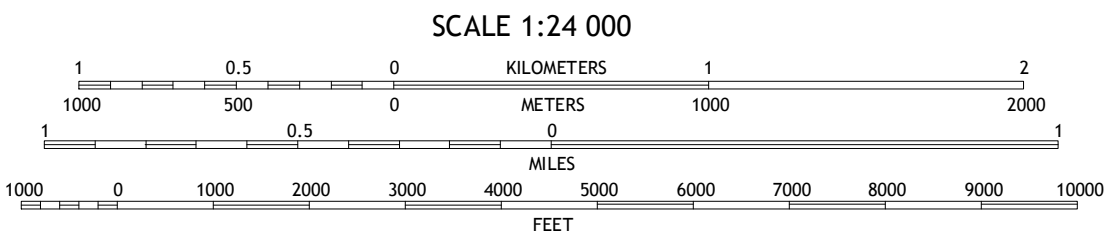


OAHE DAM QUADRANGLE
