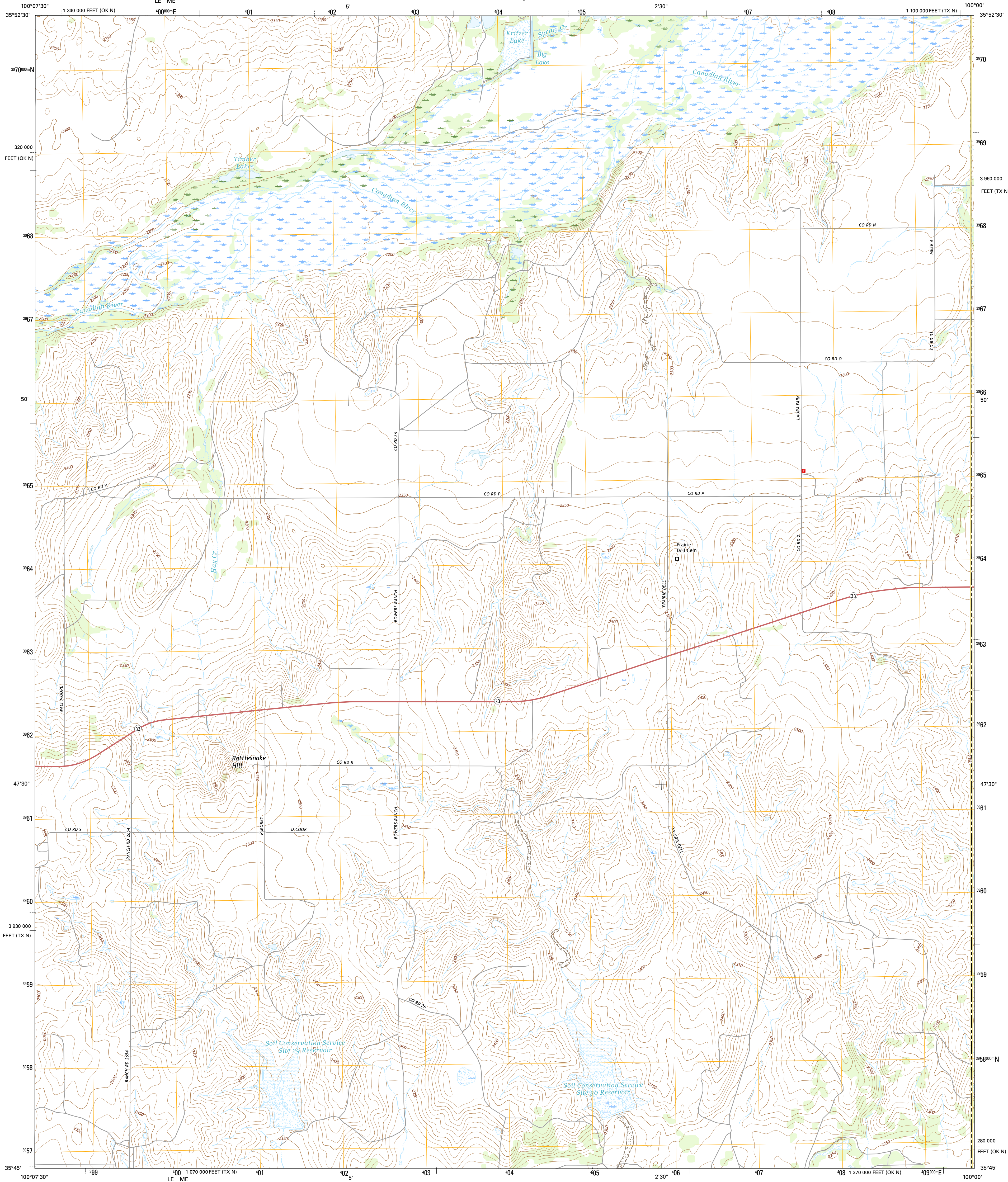

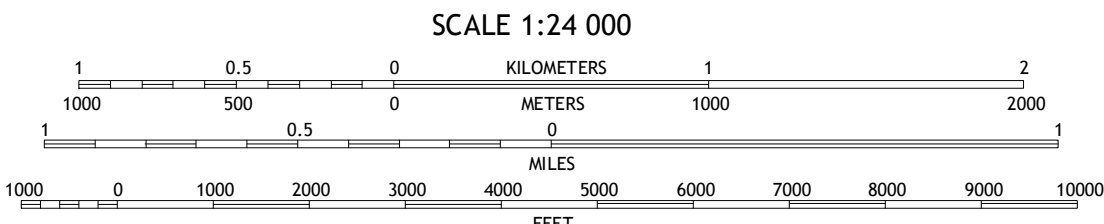
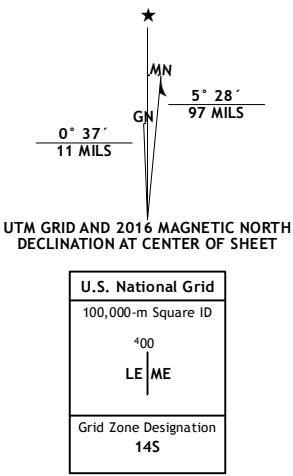
GEM QUADRANGLE
