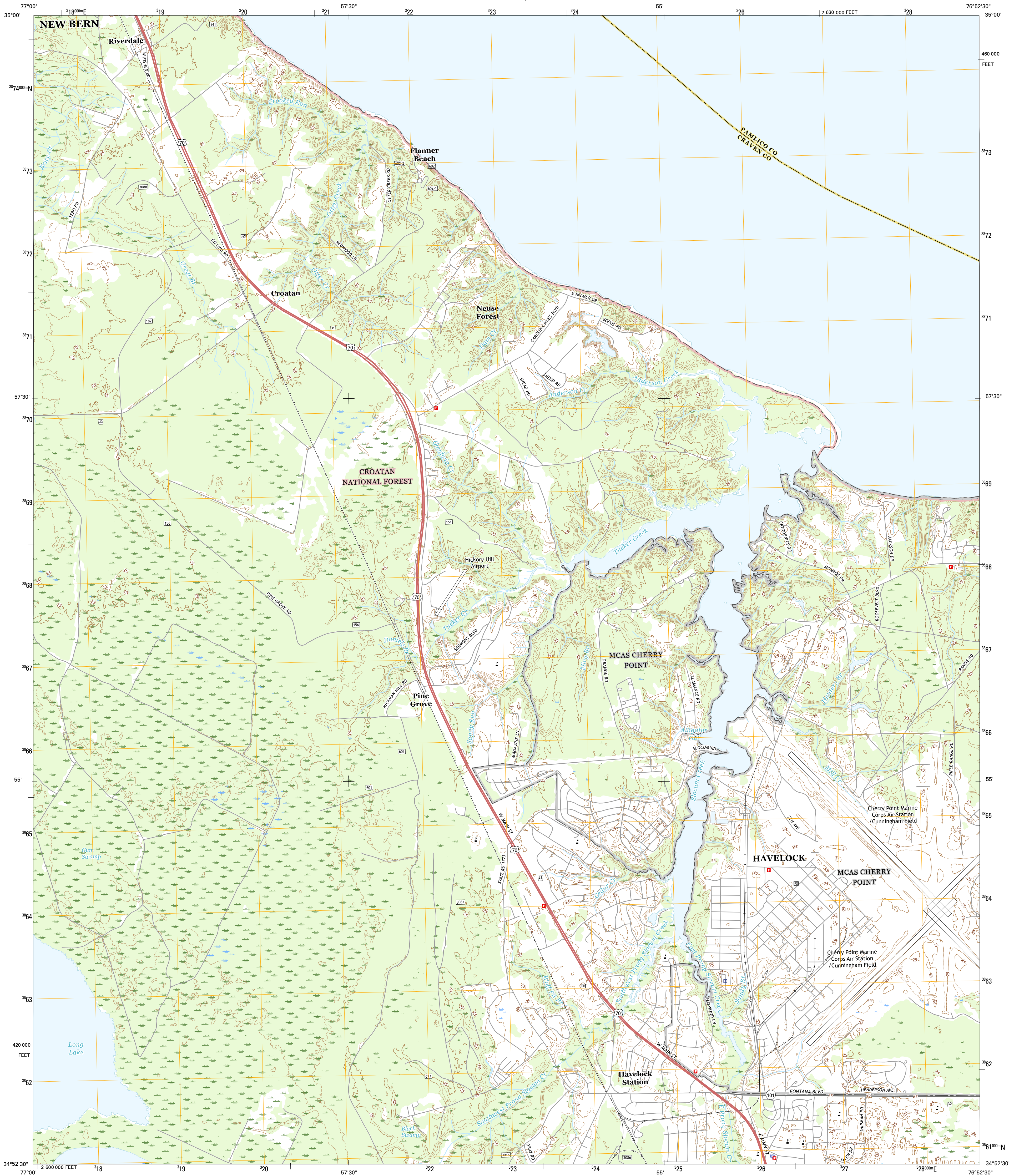

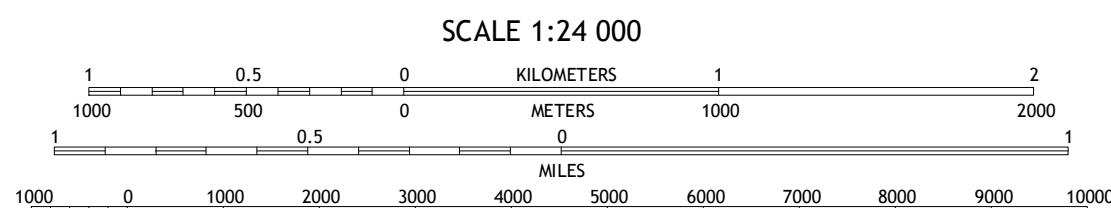
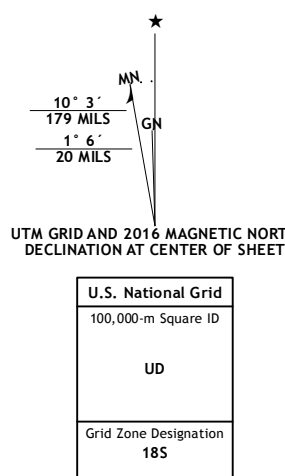
HAVELOCK QUADRANGLE

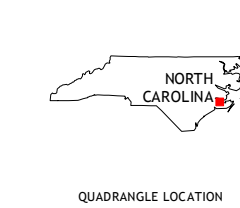
