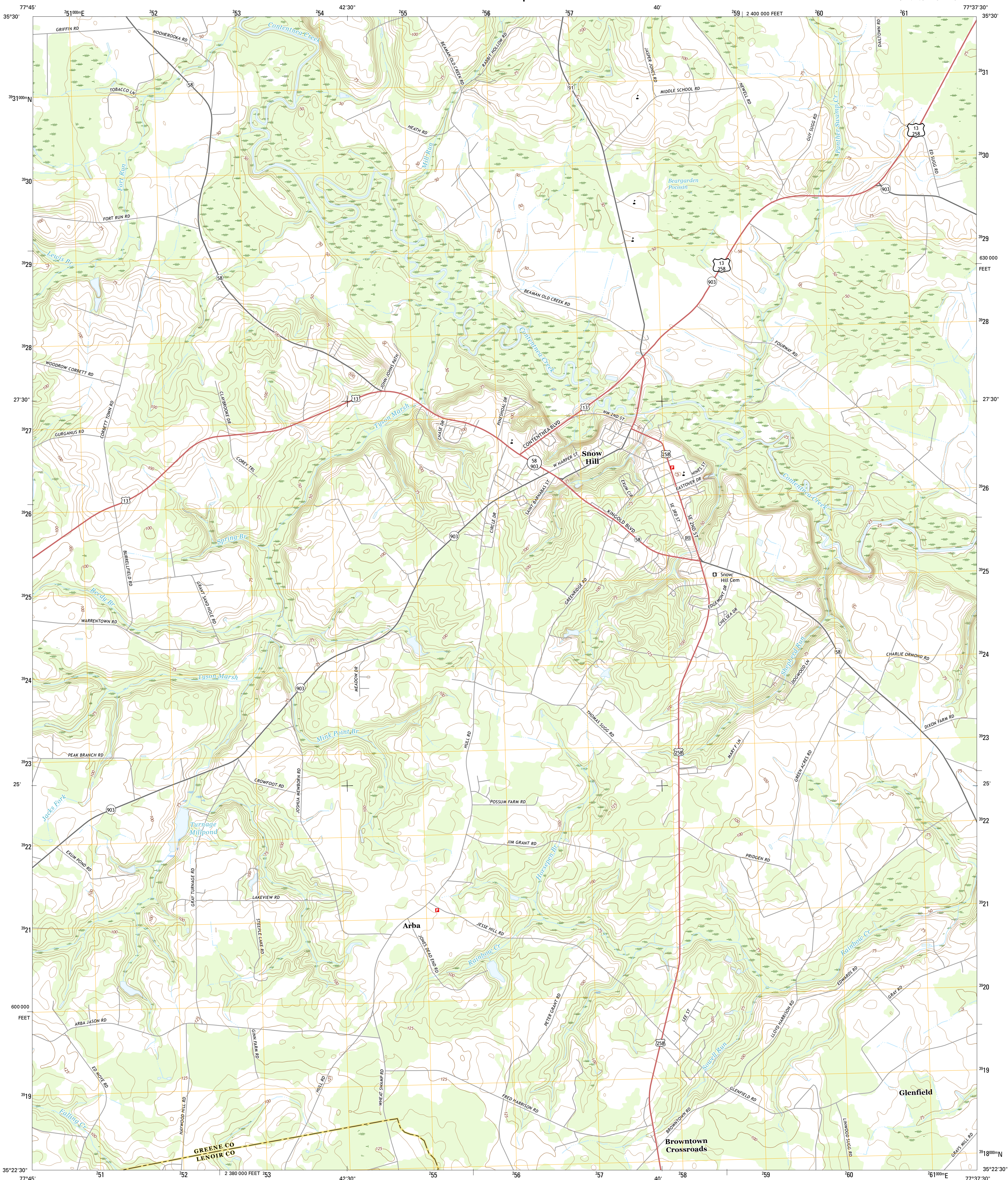

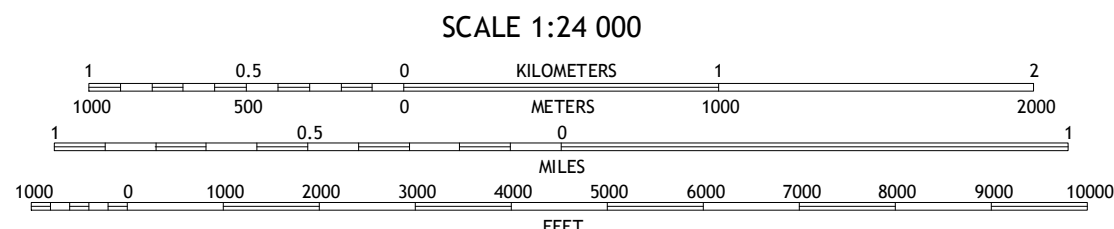
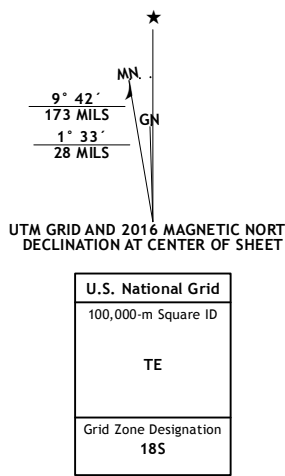
SNOW HILL QUADRANGLE

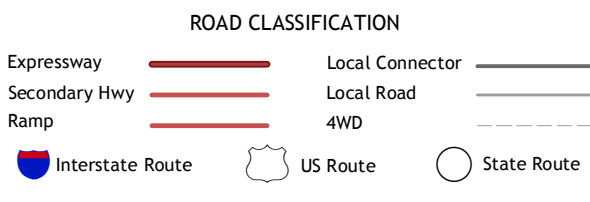
