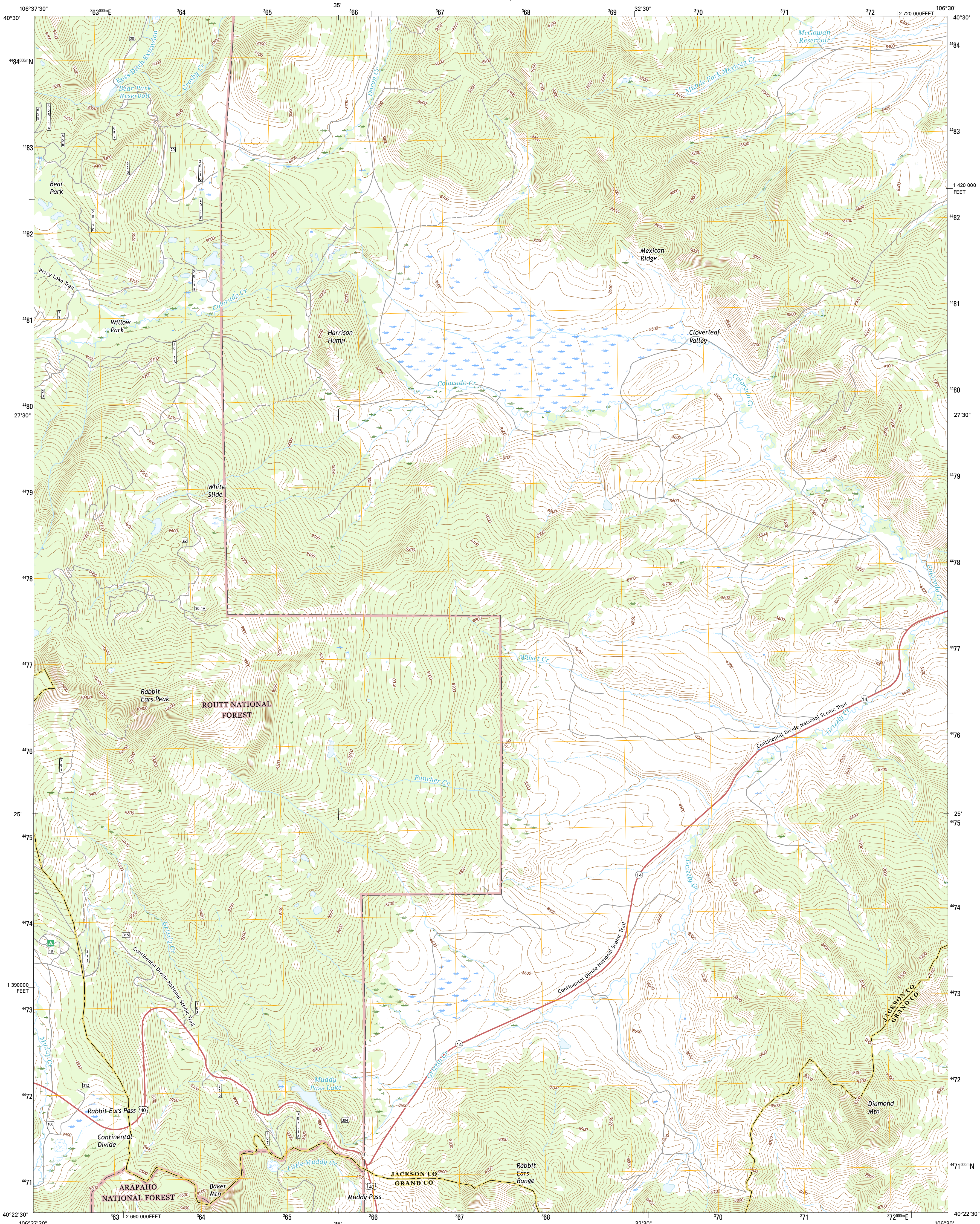

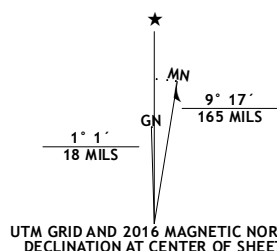
RABBIT EARS PEAK QUADRANGLE

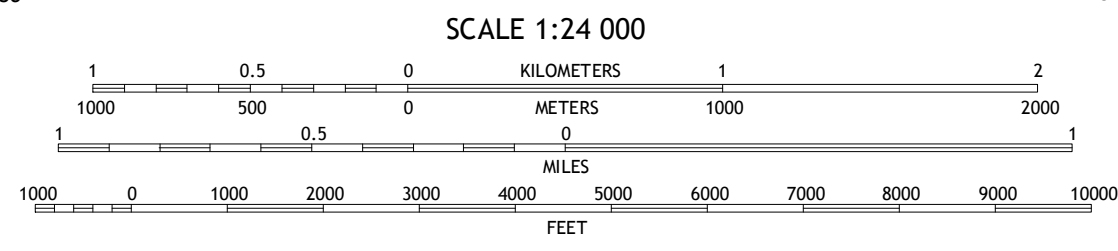

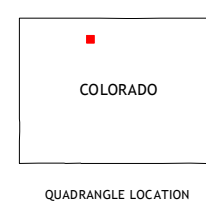
