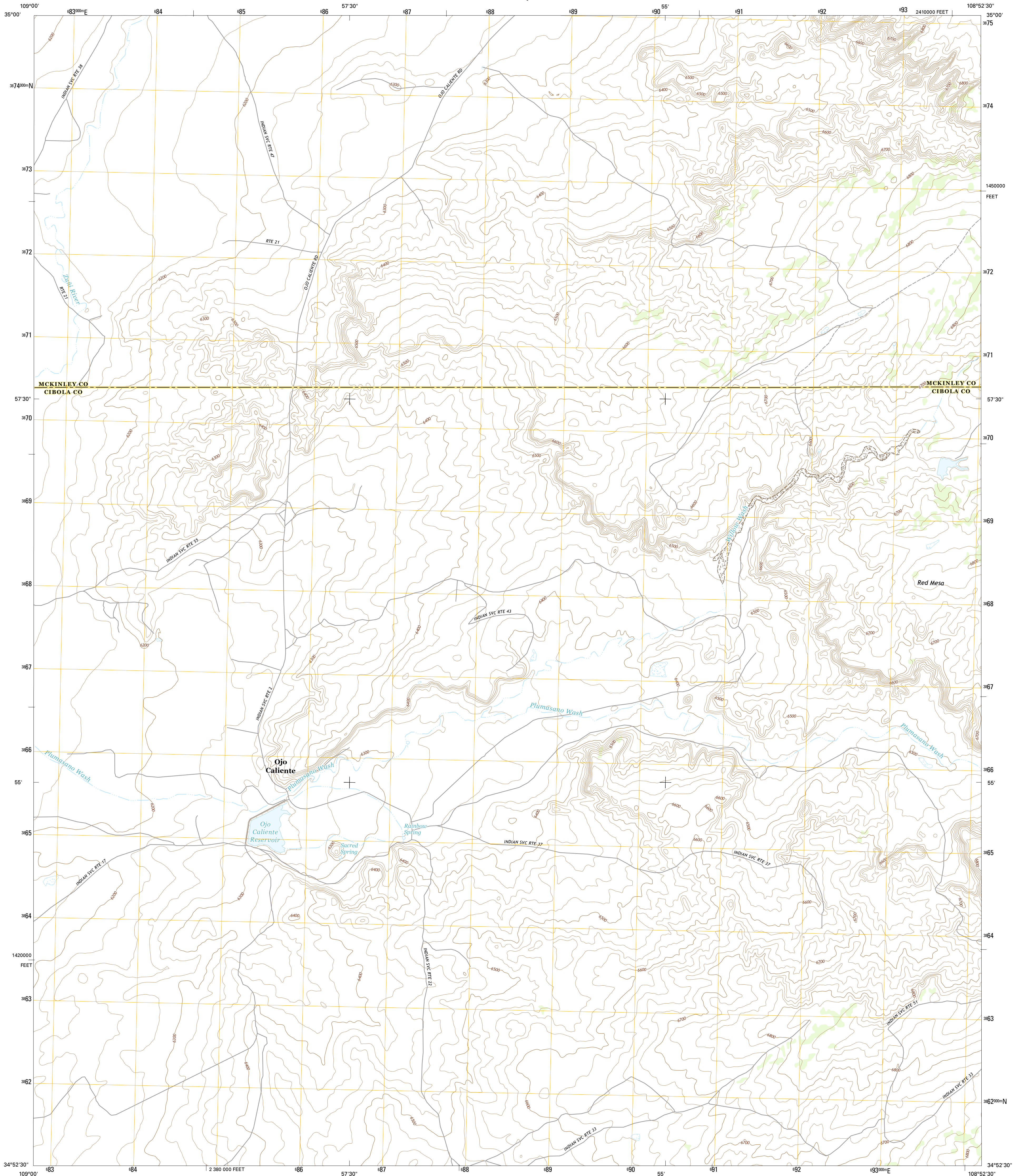

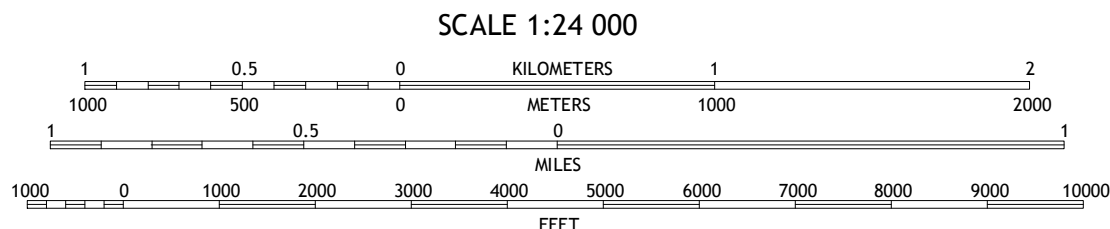
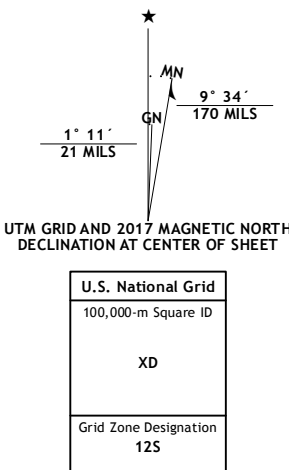


OJO CALIENTE RESERVOIR QUADRANGLE

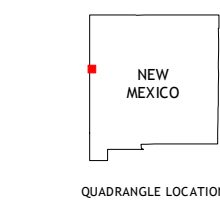
