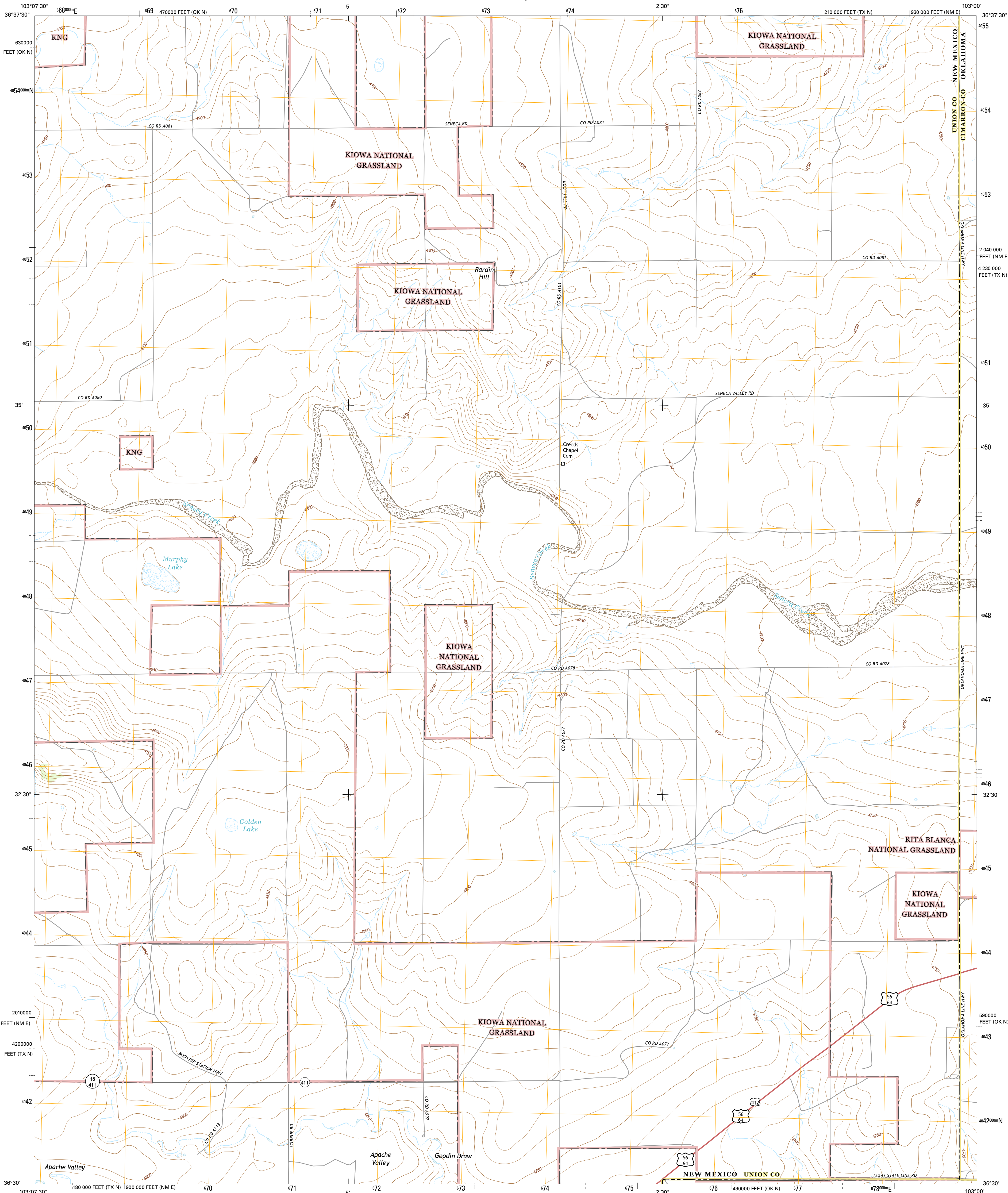

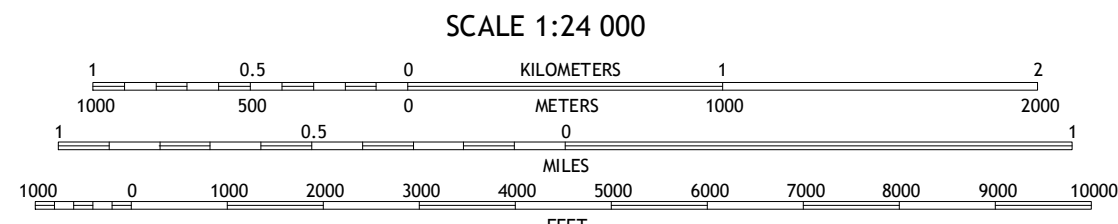


RARDIN HILL QUADRANGLE

7.5-MINUTE SERIES

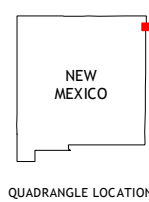
