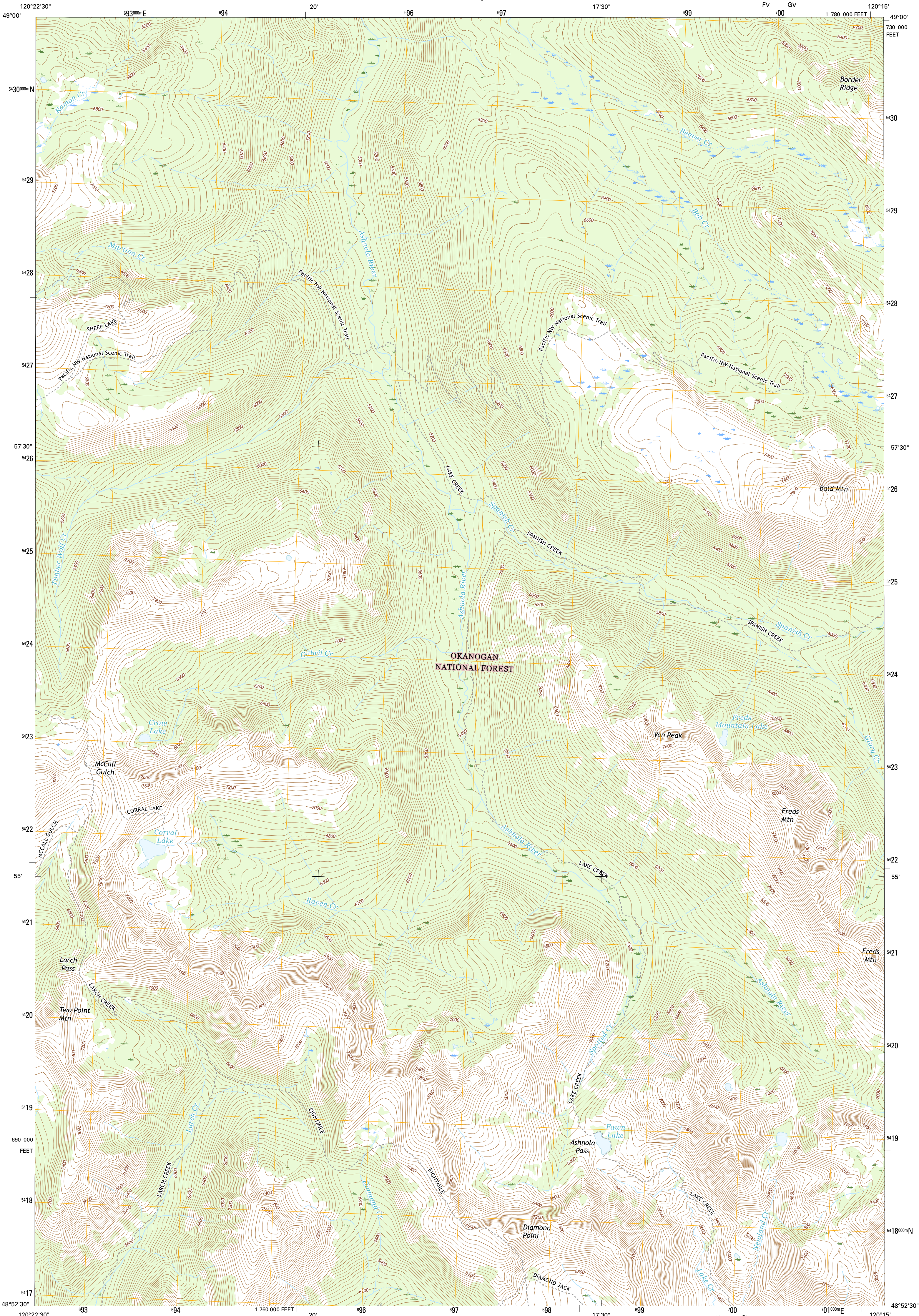

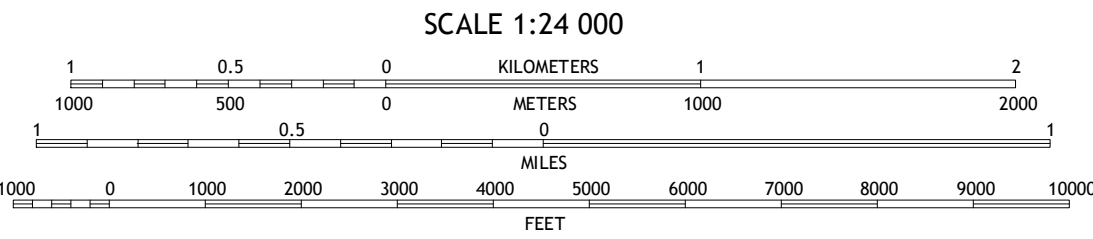
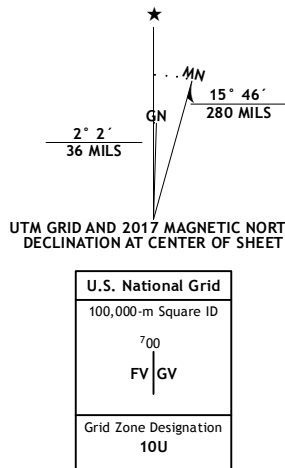
ASHNOLA PASS QUADRANGLE
