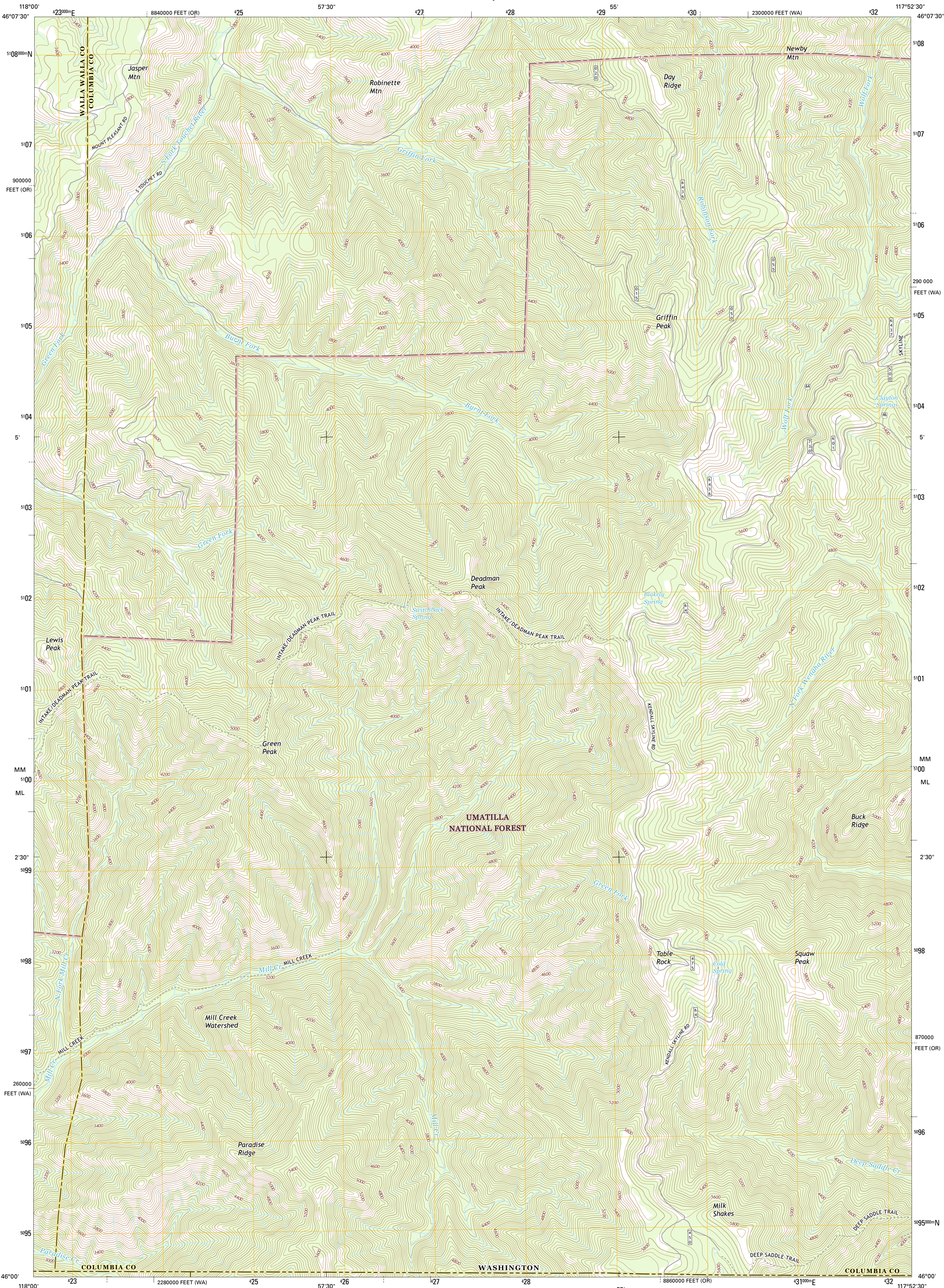

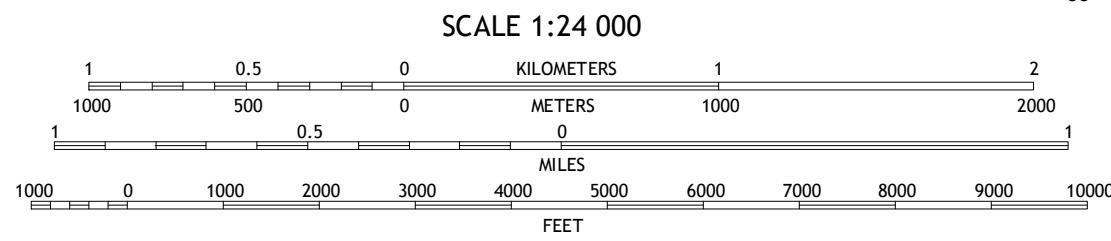
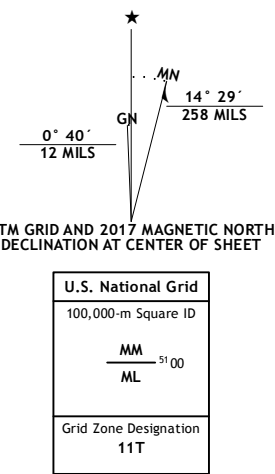
DEADMAN PEAK QUADRANGLE
