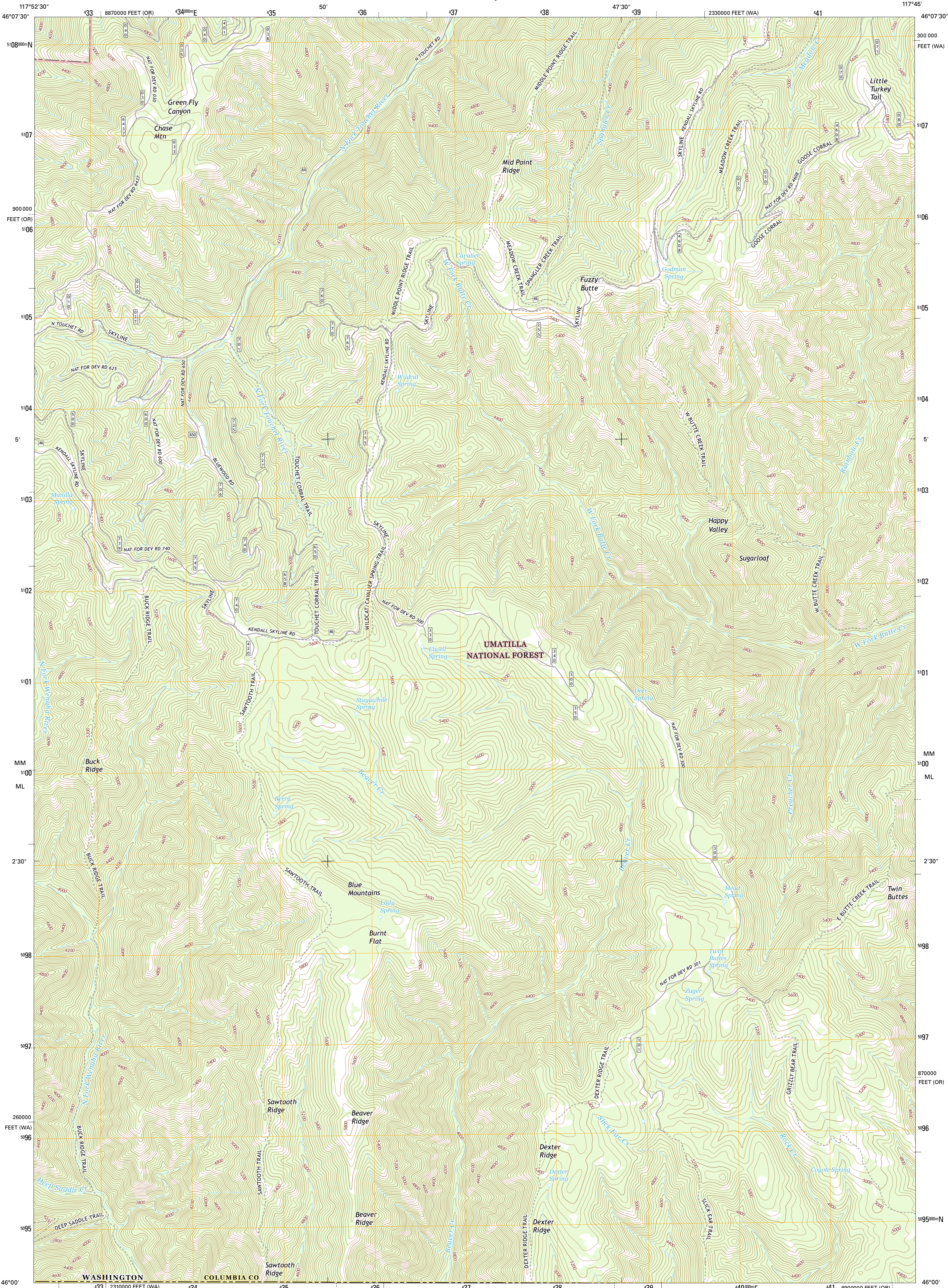

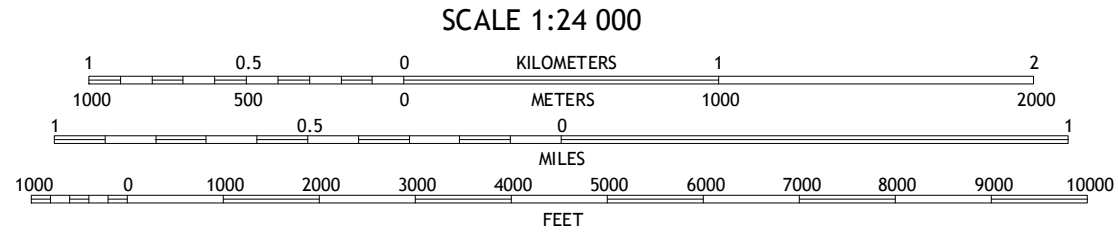
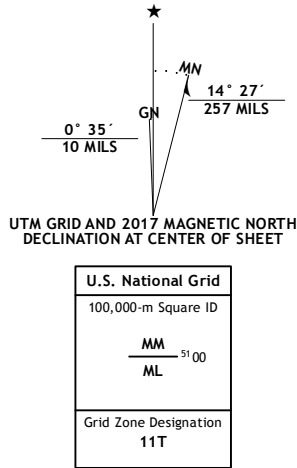
GODMAN SPRING QUADRANGLE
