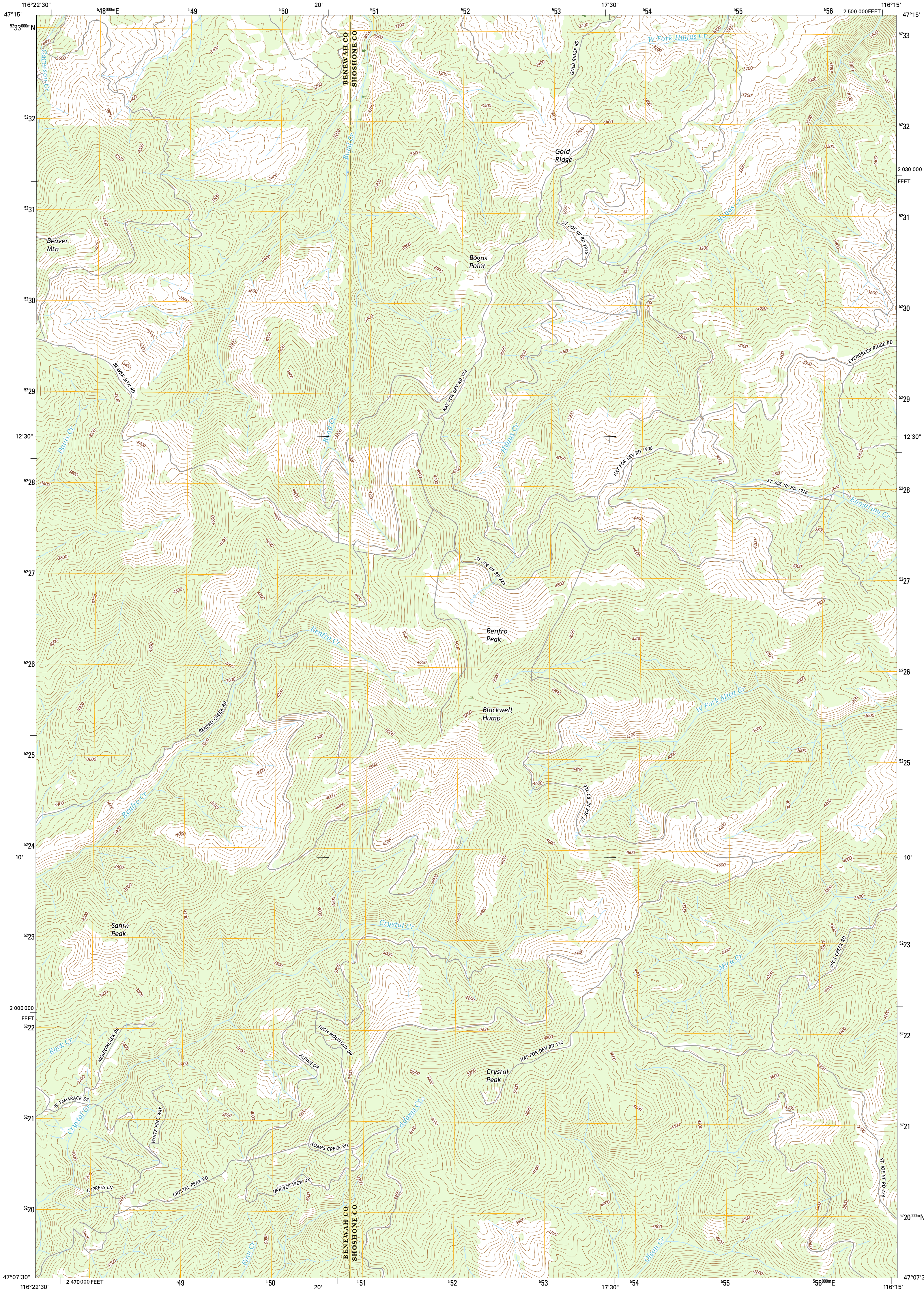

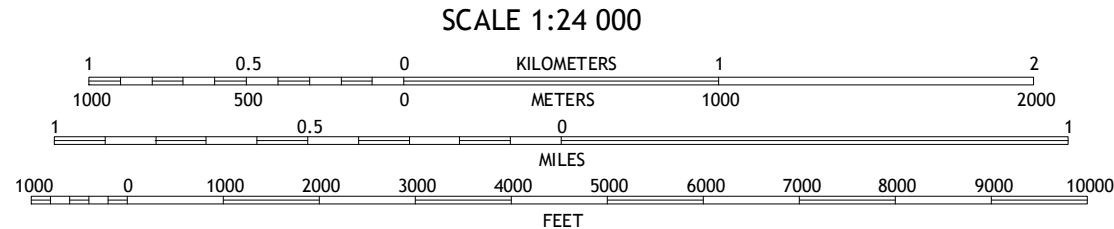
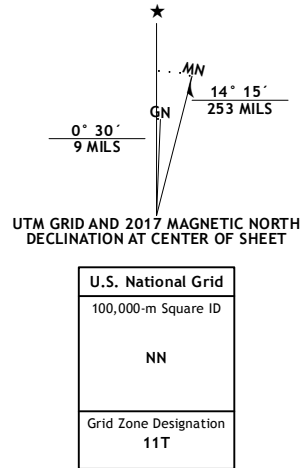
CRYSTAL PEAK QUADRANGLE
