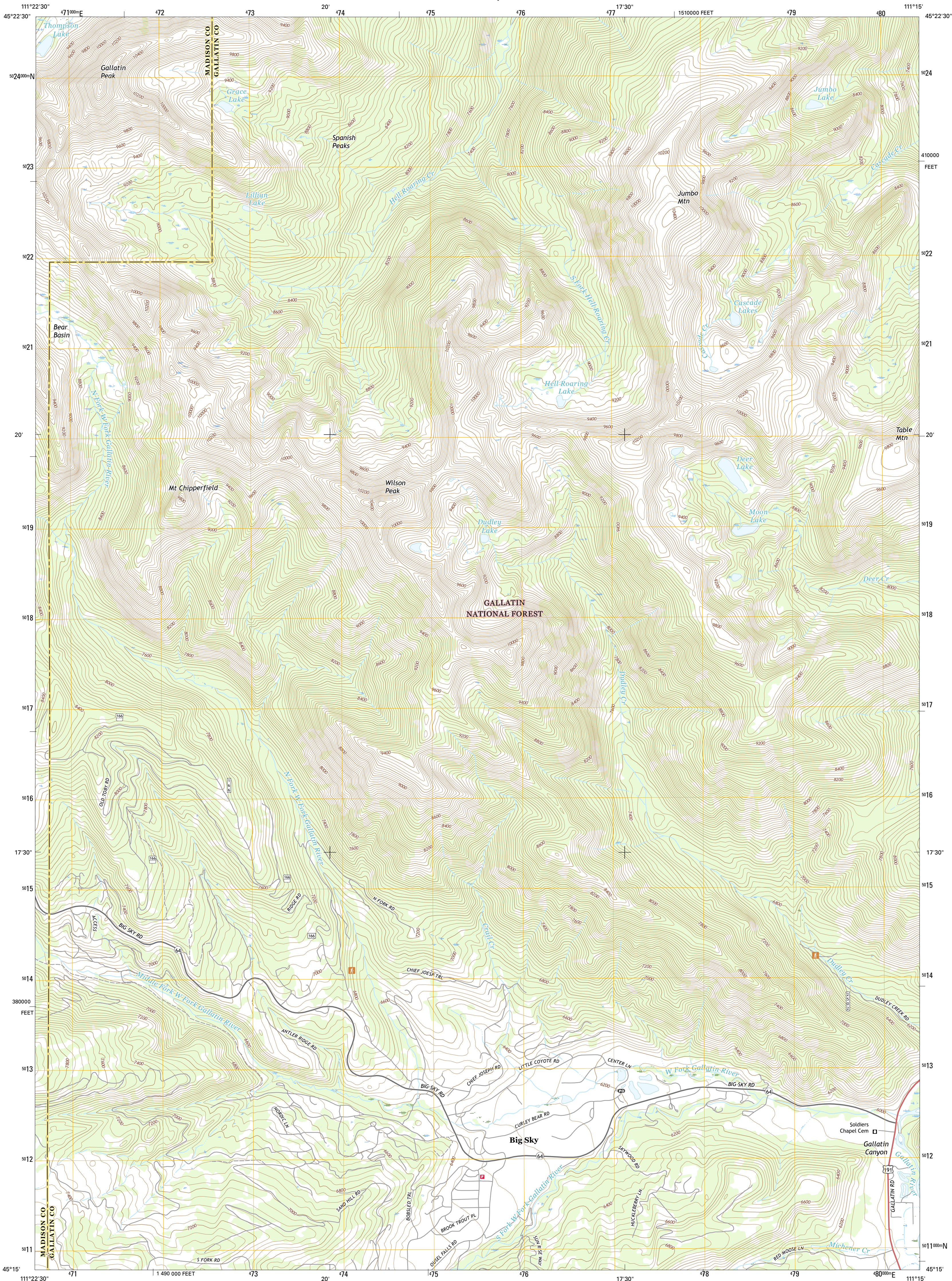

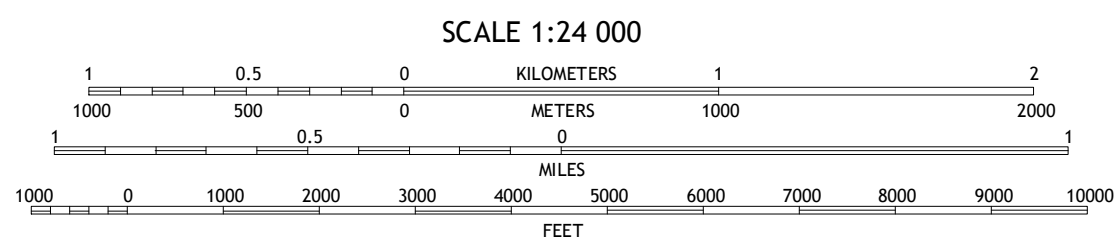
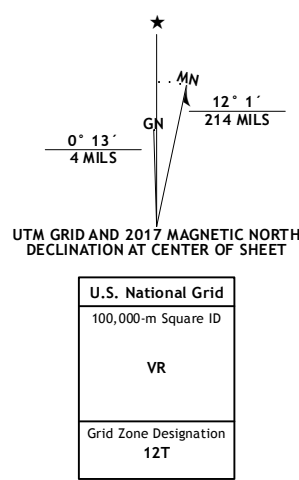
GALLATIN PEAK QUADRANGLE

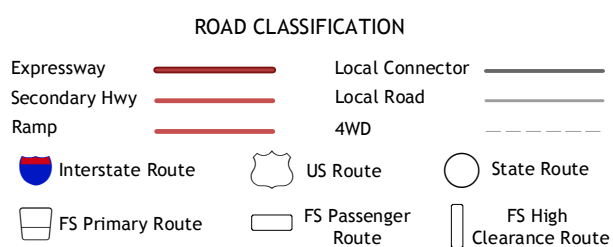
