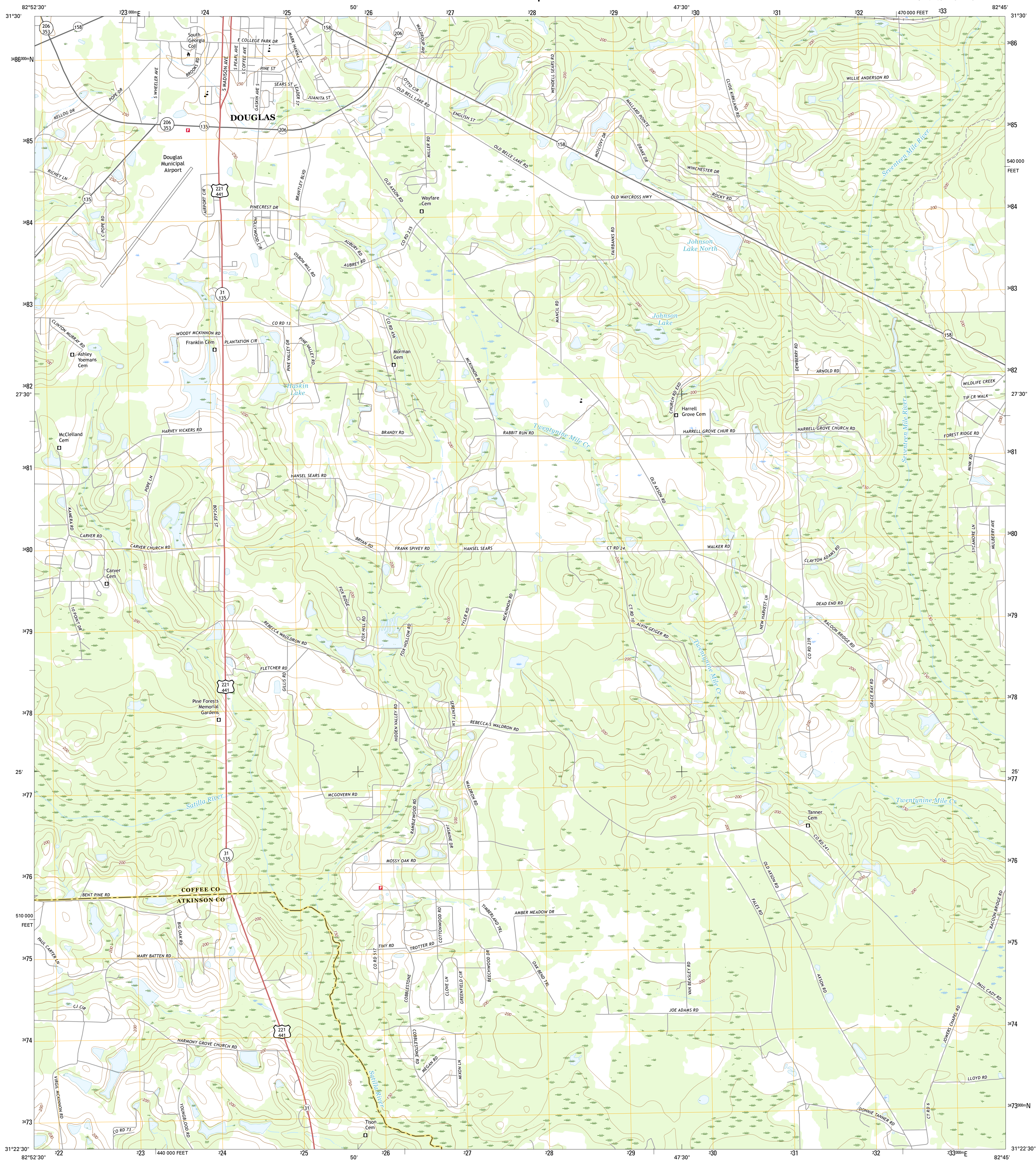

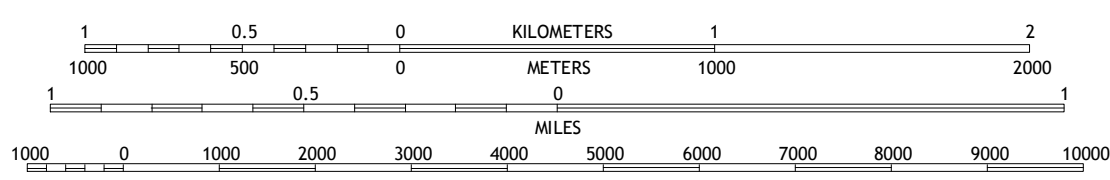
Diagram illustrating the relationship between Magnetic North (MN) and Grid North (GN) with declination and distance values:
